Preface

This volume is the oldest surviving survey for the moiety of Ewyas Lacy under the jurisdiction of Lord Abergavenny. The information seems to have been gathered at least as early as September of 1624 and last additions penned on the 4th of August, 1626. There are notes in the margins in a later hand, (Mich. 1718) on various tenements and leases. In this edition that hand is italicised and coloured blue. Comparisons with other surveys for this manor indicate that it was not unusual for the larger surveys of this manor to be carried out over a period of two years.

Earlier known surveys for this part of Ewyas Lacy are “Two booke of record one of the ij^o Elizabeth thother of 29^o Elizabeth”¹.

The typescript in this volume has been prepared over many months using the original survey² and also checked against a handwritten copy of this original³. The copy is undated but may have been executed some time in the late 19th century. The copier had difficulty copying the damaged portions in the original. It has been possible to decipher a little more in places, however it may be that the copier was working from a photograph of the original which would have made it difficult to distinguish words which belonged to pages further on in the volume, but showed through on the top page in the damaged portion. The copy has definitely been invaluable to compile a master text as fragments of the document have broken away between then and today and even if it is the case of one letter this can sometimes be enough to identify the possible rendering of a previously unrecognisable word.

**Speciall observacions and Informacions
in the manner of Ewias Lacy as
followeth.**

First the sayd manner is a goodly manner and extendeth in length 7 myles & in bredthe 4 myles.

It consisteth of pasture, meadowe and common. the land is for the most parte good & fruitefull.

Besides it is generally well wooded, and there are also three brookes or rivers which runne through it. viz. Olchon, Monnowe and Esclie so that it is singularly well watered. There is also lymestone in some partes of the lordshipp which is an excellent helpe for the bettering of their landes which in that partes with with good successe they doe much practise.

Besides there is greate store of slate and paving stone in very greate abundance of such largeness as I never sawe the like in any place. /

There are many goodly commons belonging to the lord Bergevenny for his parte of the sayd manner which shall hereafter in particuler apeare. /

Touching the customes of the sayd manner. I am enformed by the relacion of Thomas John Lewys who is a very old man, & hath gathered the rent thereof for a longe tyme that [] they are theise.

Touching heriottes the old bayliffe sayeth that if any freeholder doe convey his land either upon his heire or in ioynchure to his wifffe in such case there commeth no Heriott to the lord till the death of the wifffe surviving her husband. but upon the death or surrender of very coppiholder there commeth to the lord a heriott.

Also there is no heriott in kinde to be payd for any land where there is not or hath not bene some messuage, but only v^s in money. There is also some question that where the freehoder dyeth not seised of any cattell though there be a messuage upon the lande that in that case also v^s and no more is payable. / sed de hoc quere /

The lord by his officers doe (besides the two greate leetes) keepe a courte at Longtowne for determining of debttes trespasses etc. every 3 weekes which by reason of the greate appearance the multitude of tennantes of all sortes and the manifold contentions used to be commonly among those kinde of people, can not choose but be very beneficiale to the lord of the mannor, in regard there is levyed to the lordes use for every matter once sommoned, whether after compounded, or not vj^d besides amerciamentes for defaltes.
