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10th May 1853 At a Parish Meeting held this day after notice given by Roger Williams Overseer of the Poor of the Parish of Kollston for the purpose of rating the Land taken by the said Railway Company we the ratepayers here present agreed that the Acres taken by the said Company is 4 Acres of the Park and 1/2 Acre of the Leath. We Value the Land taken by the said Company at £25/- and that the said be rated at the Term of 1856 and that the sum be deducted from the Park Land and Leath Land according to the above Acreage.

Minutes of proceedings at a parish Meeting of the ratepayers of Kollston held the 10th day of May 1853 at Kollston Chapel in the County of Denbighshire.

Resolved. That the rate of Samuel Johnson be reduced by the sum of twelve Pounds & James Pugh by the sum of two Pounds, & that the same viz fourteen Pounds be charged on the Newport & Hereford Railway.
