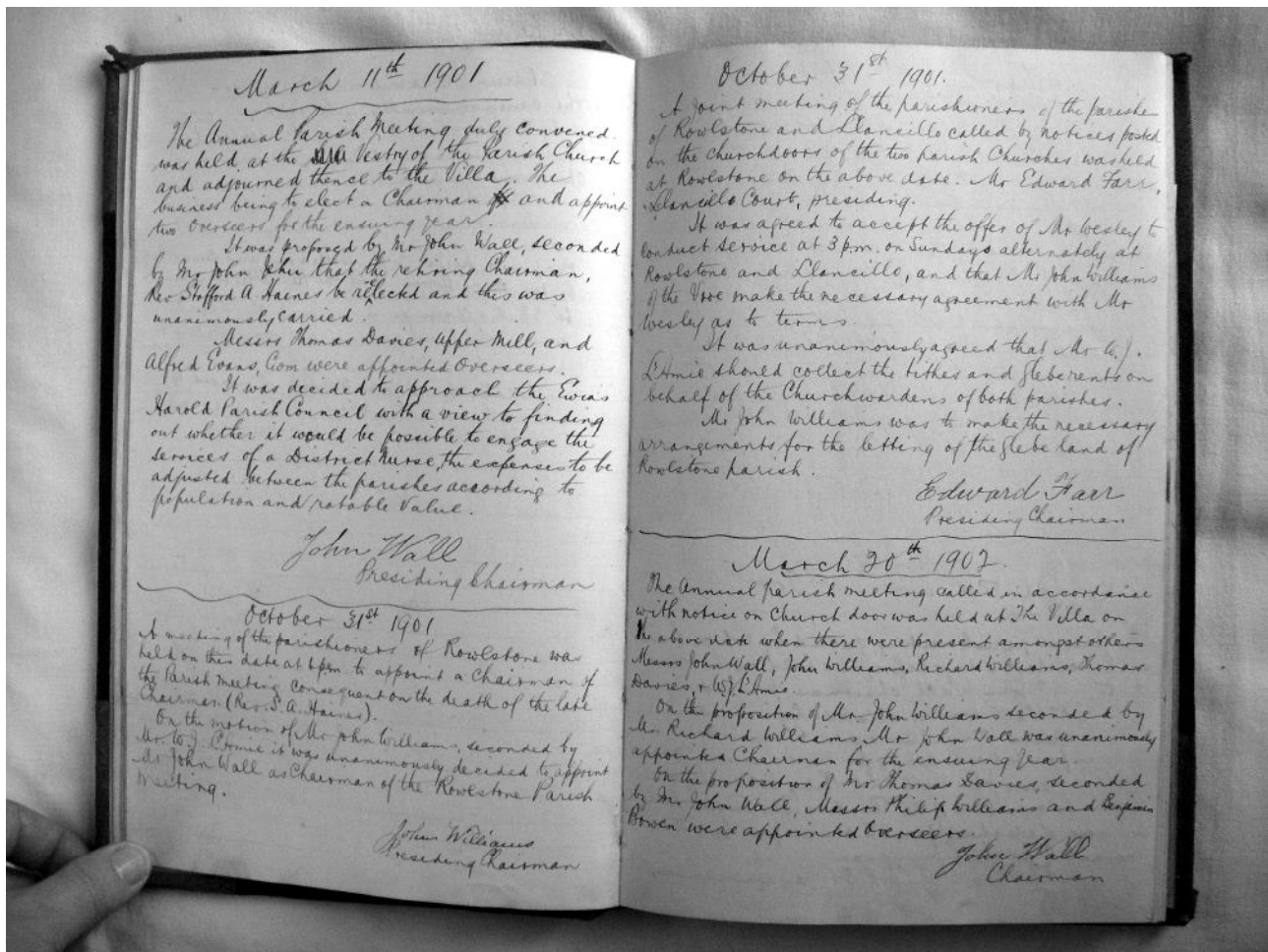

March 11th 1901

The Annual Parish Meeting duly convened was held at the Villa of the Parish Church and adjourned thence to the Villa. The business being to elect a Chairman and appoint two Overseers for the ensuing year.

It was proposed by Mr John Wall, seconded by Mr John Phe that the retiring Chairman, Mr Clifford A. Haines be re-elected and this was unanimously carried.

Messrs Thomas Davies, Upper Mill, and Alfred Evans, Com were appointed Overseers.

It was decided to approach the Ewyas Harold Parish Council with a view to finding out whether it would be possible to engage the services of a District Nurse, the expense to be adjusted between the parishes according to population and rateable value.

October 31st 1901

A meeting of the parishioners of Rowstone was held on this date at 10pm to appoint a Chairman of the Parish Meeting consequent on the death of the late Chairman (Mr S. A. Haines).

On the motion of Mr John Williams, seconded by Mr W. J. Comie it was unanimously decided to appoint Mr John Wall as Chairman of the Rowstone Parish Meeting.

October 31st 1901.

A joint meeting of the parishioners of the parishes of Rowstone and Llancillo called by notices posted on the Churchdoors of the two parish Churches was held at Rowstone on the above date. Mr Edward Farr, Llancillo Court, presiding.

It was agreed to accept the offer of Mr Wesley to conduct service at 3pm. on Sundays alternately at Rowstone and Llancillo, and that Mr John Williams of the Vicar make the necessary agreement with Mr Wesley as to terms.

It was unanimously agreed that Mr W. J. Comie should collect the tithes and glebe rents on behalf of the Churchwardens of both parishes.

Mr John Williams was to make the necessary arrangements for the letting of the Glebe land of Rowstone parish.

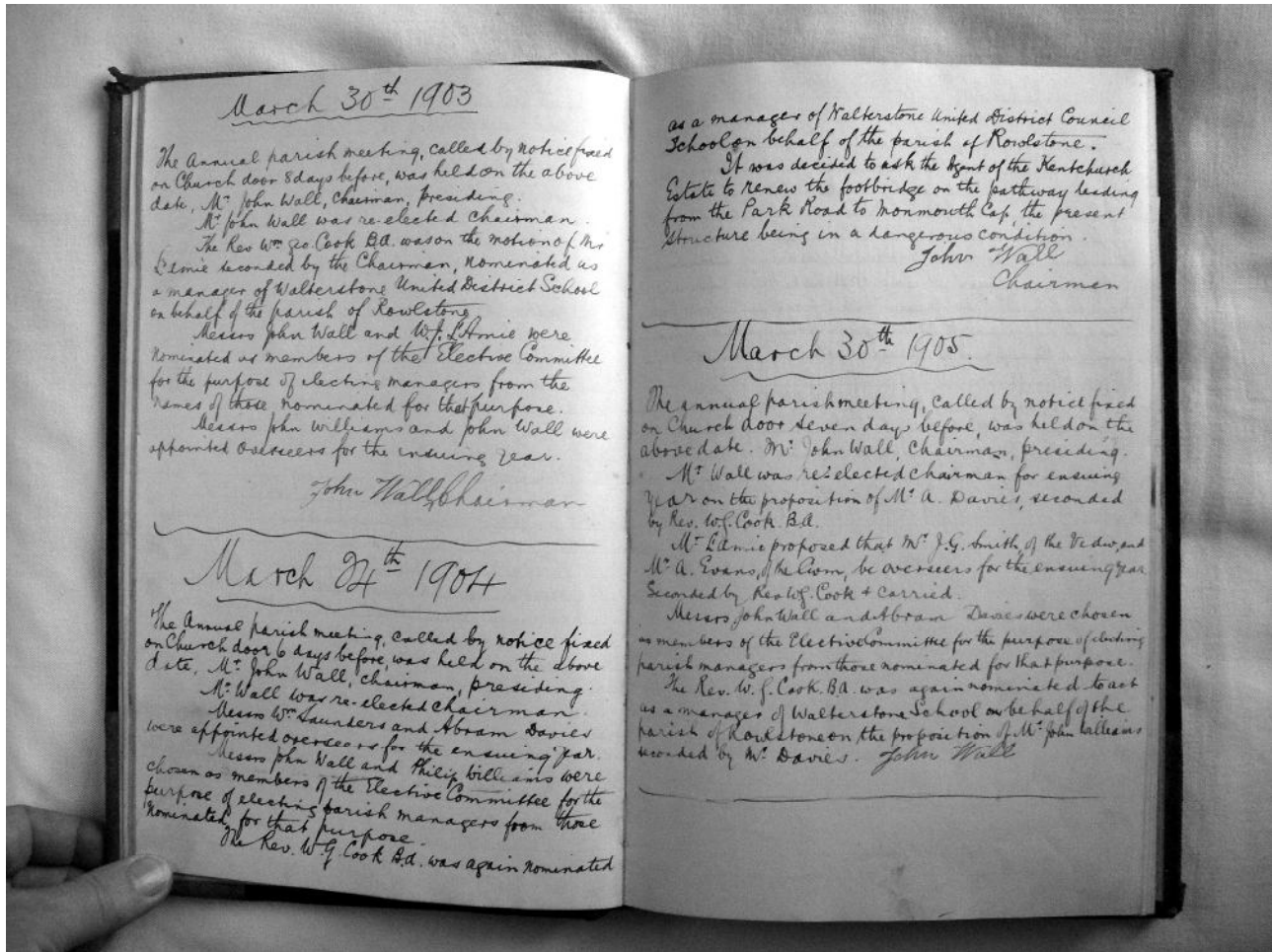
On the proposition of Mr John Williams seconded by Mr Richard Williams, Mr John Wall was unanimously appointed Chairman for the ensuing year.

March 30th 1903

The Annual parish meeting, called by notice fixed on Church door 8 days before, was held on the above date, Mr. John Wall, Chairman, presiding.

Mr. John Wall was re-elected Chairman. The Rev. W. Geo. Cook B.D. was on the motion of Mr. Lennie seconded by the Chairman, nominated as a manager of Walbertone United District School on behalf of the parish of Rowdstone.

Messrs John Wall and W. Lennie were nominated as members of the Elective Committee for the purpose of electing managers from the names of those nominated for that purpose.

Messrs John Williams and John Wall were appointed Overseers for the ensuing year.

March 24th 1904

The Annual parish meeting, called by notice fixed on Church door 6 days before, was held on the above date, Mr. John Wall, Chairman, presiding.

Mr. Wall was re-elected Chairman.

Messrs W. Saunders and Abram Davies were appointed Overseers for the ensuing year.

Messrs John Wall and Philip Williams were chosen as members of the Elective Committee for the purpose of electing parish managers from those nominated for that purpose.

The Rev. W. Geo. Cook B.D. was again nominated

as a manager of Walbertone United District Council School on behalf of the parish of Rowdstone.

It was decided to ask the Agent of the Kentchurch Estate to renew the footbridge on the pathway leading from the Park Road to Monmouth Gap, the present structure being in a dangerous condition.

March 30th 1905

The annual parish meeting, called by notice fixed on Church door seven days before, was held on the above date. Mr. John Wall, Chairman, presiding.

Mr. Wall was re-elected Chairman for ensuing year on the proposition of Mr. A. Davies, seconded by Rev. W. Geo. Cook B.D.

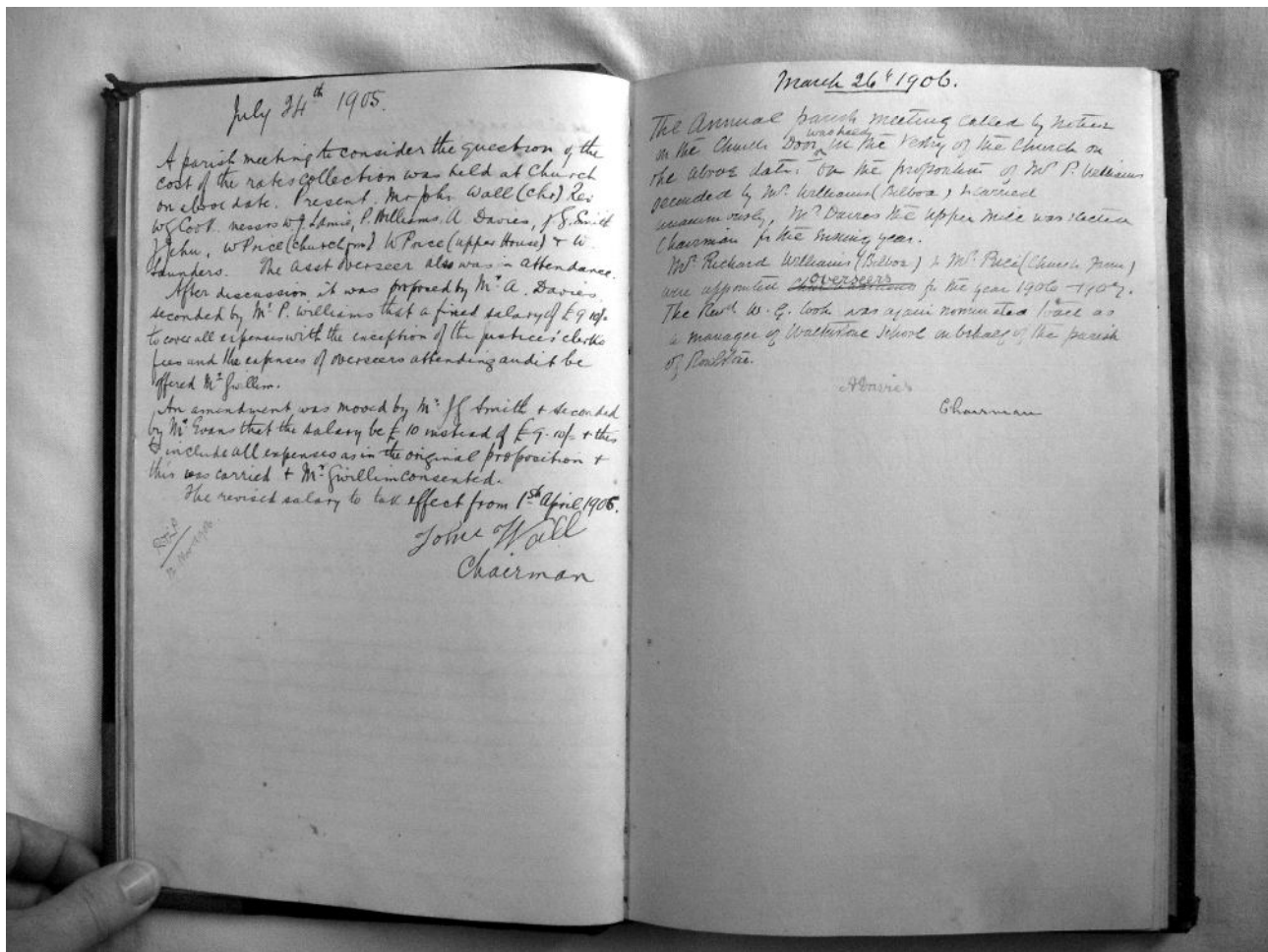
Mr. Lennie proposed that Mr. J. G. Smith of the Redwood and Mr. A. Evans of the Lion, be Overseers for the ensuing year. Seconded by Rev. W. Geo. Cook & Carried.

Messrs John Wall and Abram Davies were chosen as members of the Elective Committee for the purpose of electing parish managers from those nominated for that purpose.

The Rev. W. Geo. Cook B.D. was again nominated to act as a manager of Walbertone School on behalf of the parish of Rowdstone on the proposition of Mr. John Williams seconded by Mr. Davies. John Wall

July 24th 1905.

A parish meeting to consider the question of the cost of the rakes collection was held at Church on above date. Present. Mr John Wall (Chs) Rev W. G. Cook, Messrs W. J. Lewis, P. Williams, A. Davies, J. S. Smith, J. John, W. Price (Churchman) W. Price (Upper House) & W. Saunders. The Vest Overseer also was in attendance.

After discussion it was proposed by Mr A. Davies seconded by Mr P. Williams that a fixed salary of £9.10s. to cover all expenses with the exception of the justice's clerk's fees and the expenses of Overseers attending and it be offered to Mr. Williams.

An amendment was moved by Mr J. Smith & seconded by Mr. Evans that the salary be £10 instead of £9.10s. & that it include all expenses as in the original proposition & this was carried & Mr. Williams consented.

The revised salary to take effect from 1st April 1906.

March 26th 1906.

The Annual parish meeting called by notice in the Church door for the Vestry of the Church on the above date. On the proposition of Mr P. Williams seconded by Mr. Williams (School) & seconded unanimously, Mr Davies the Upper House was elected Chairman for the coming year.

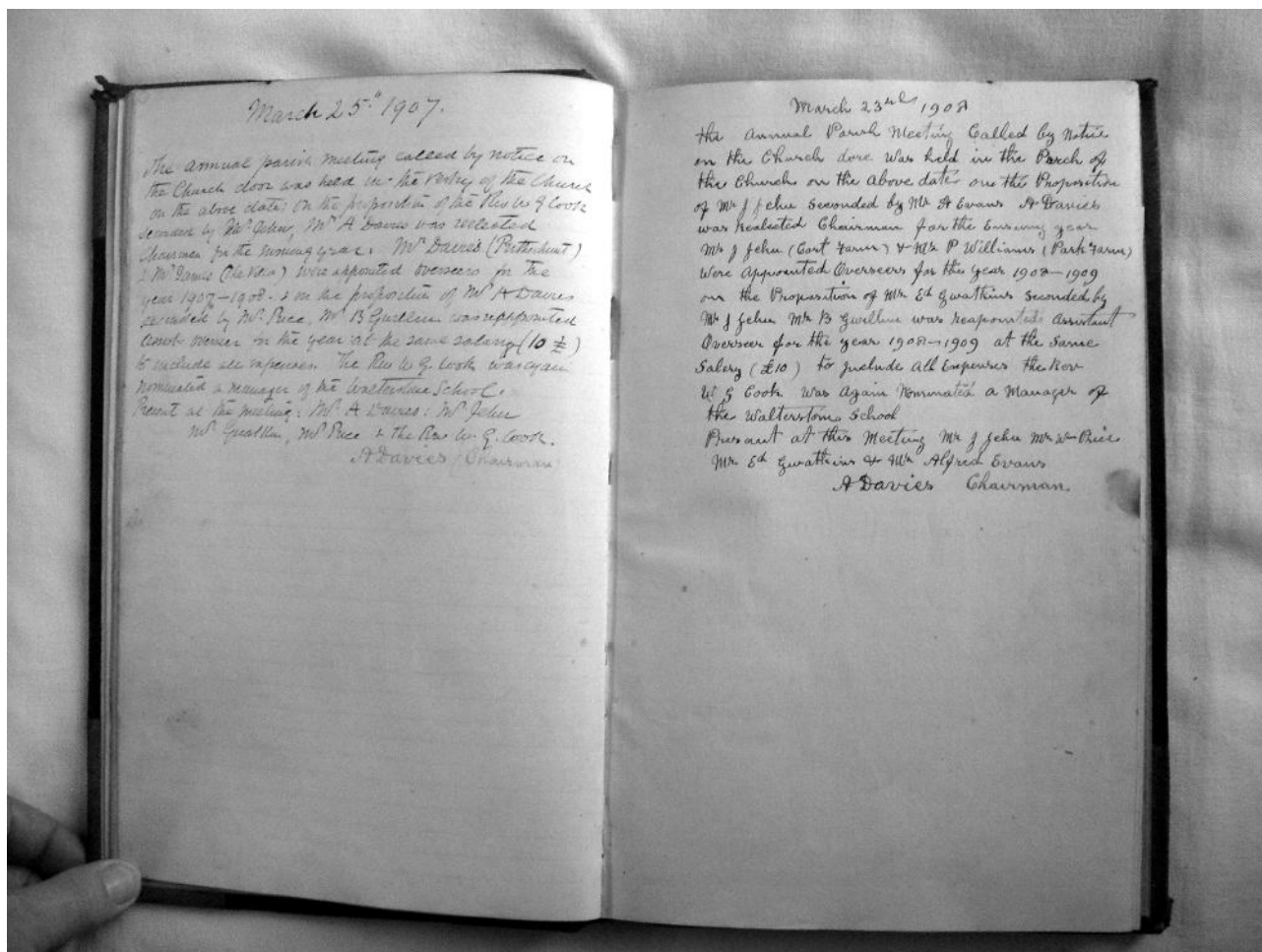

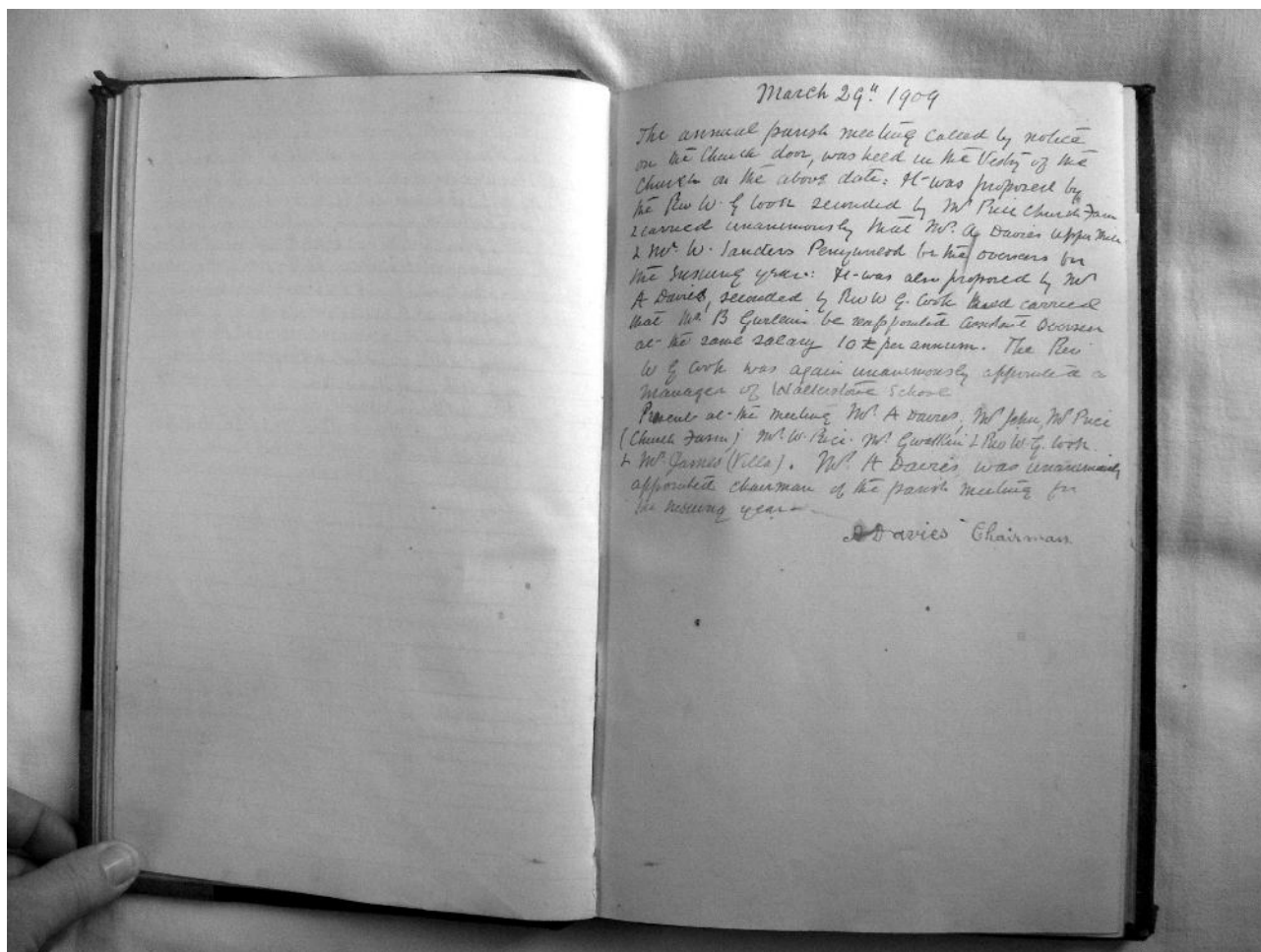

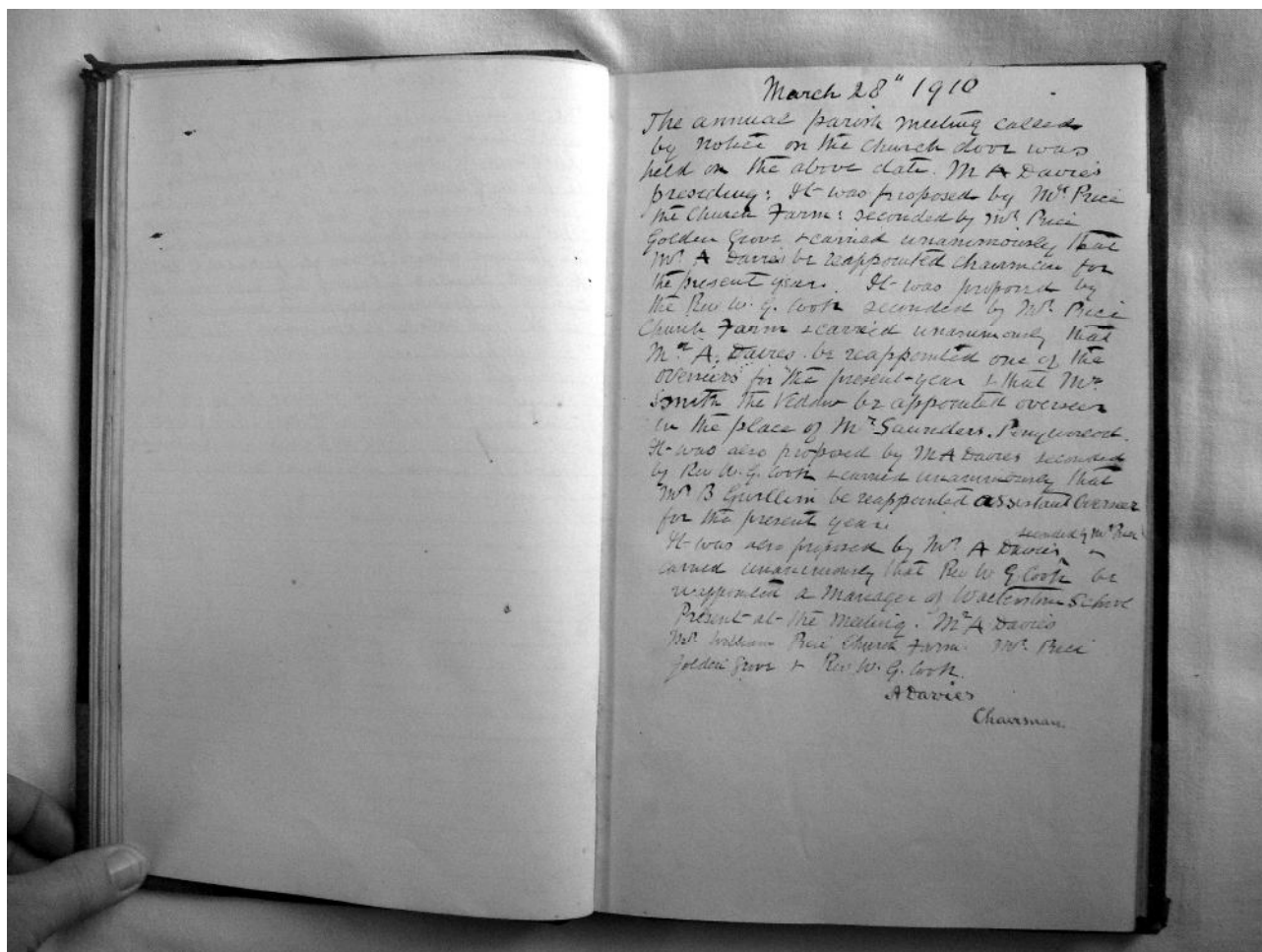
