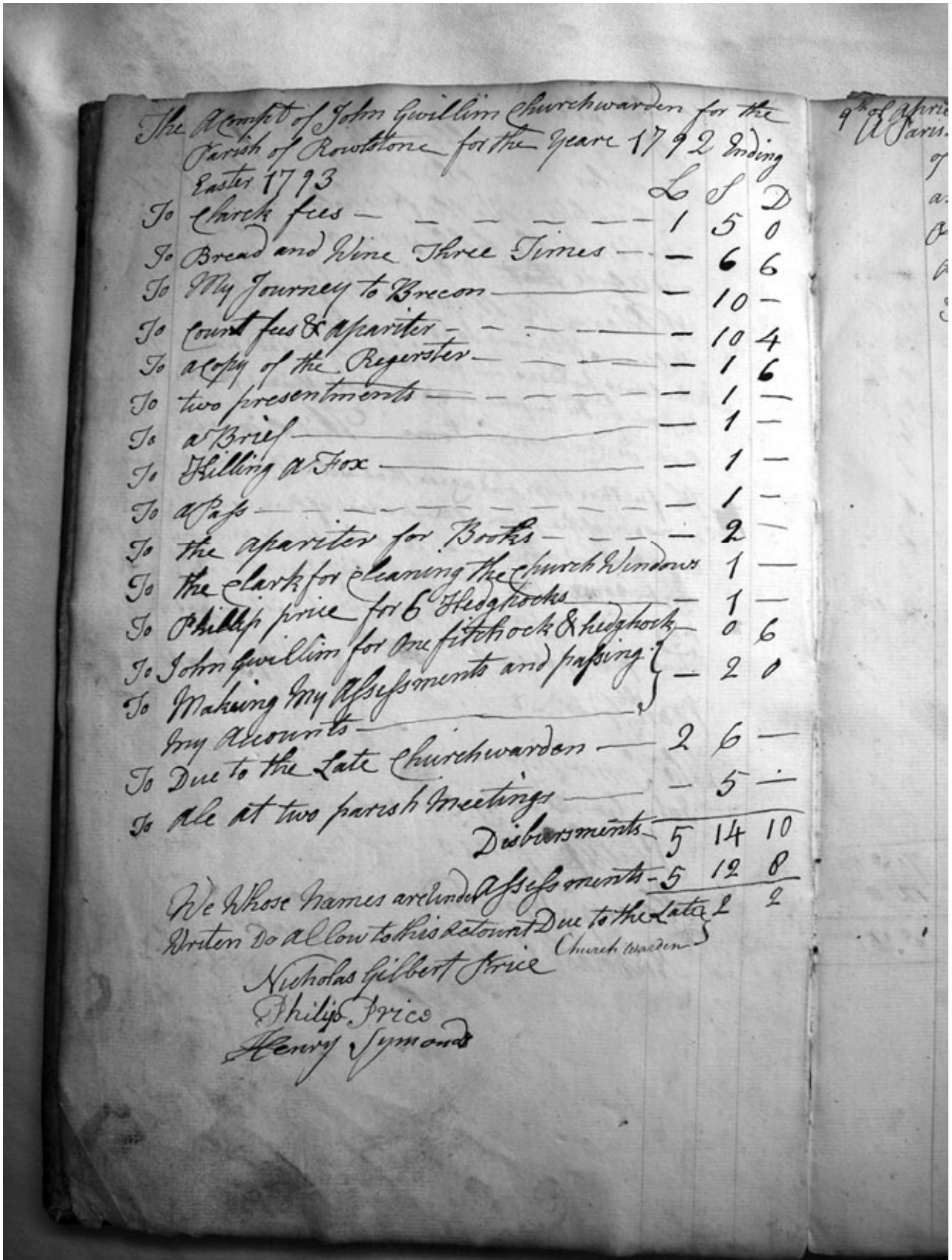

 any person or persons as the bill doth or may
 pay without calling a proper parish meeting for
 that purpose
