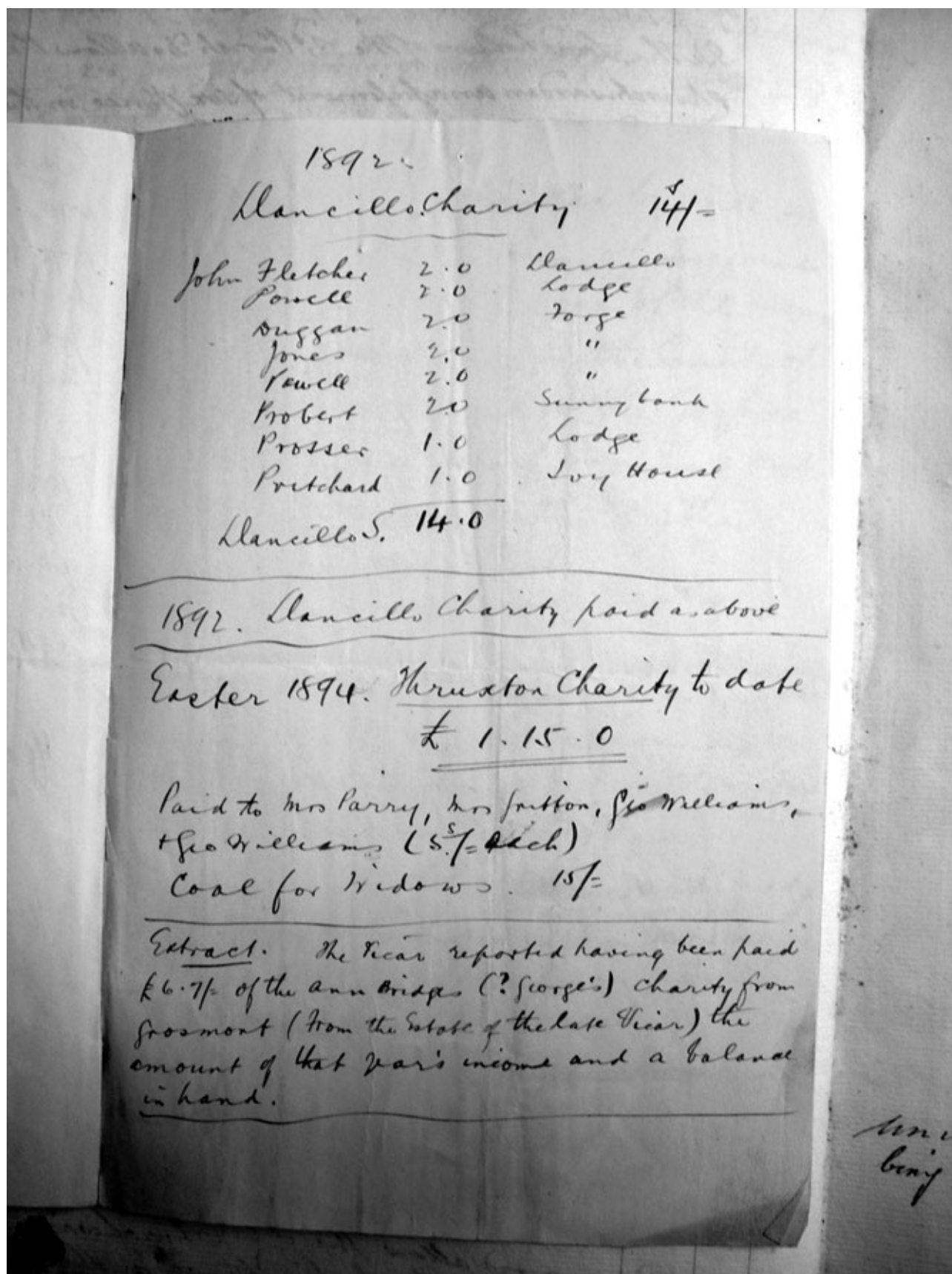

Charged on the Joyfree Estate in the parish of Frosmont and County of Monmouth, now the property of ~~Mr James~~ Mr James, Mesthys

Philip Prichard, bequeathed by will in year 1734 the sum of one pound per annum to be divided between two poor widdowers and two widdows of the said parish of Rollstone and County of Hereford. Charged on an Estate called Upper Ponthendre in parish of Clodock, County aforesaid.
