At a meeting held at Rowstons Church, on
the 11th day of Feby: 1860 in pursuance of a
meeting called by the Churchwarden Mr George
Williams, by notice affixed to the Church door
four clear days, it was proposed by the Rev W: C:
Fosk, & seconded by Mr W Hoddell that a rate
of one shilling in the pound be granted for the repairs
& restoration of Rowstons Church, one half of which
shall be collected during September 1860 & the second
moiety, before the 20th Feby 1861.

It was unanimously agreed that the above rate be
granted. And,

That the Vicar & Churchwarden for the term being,
be appointed in carrying out the plans laid before
the meeting.




