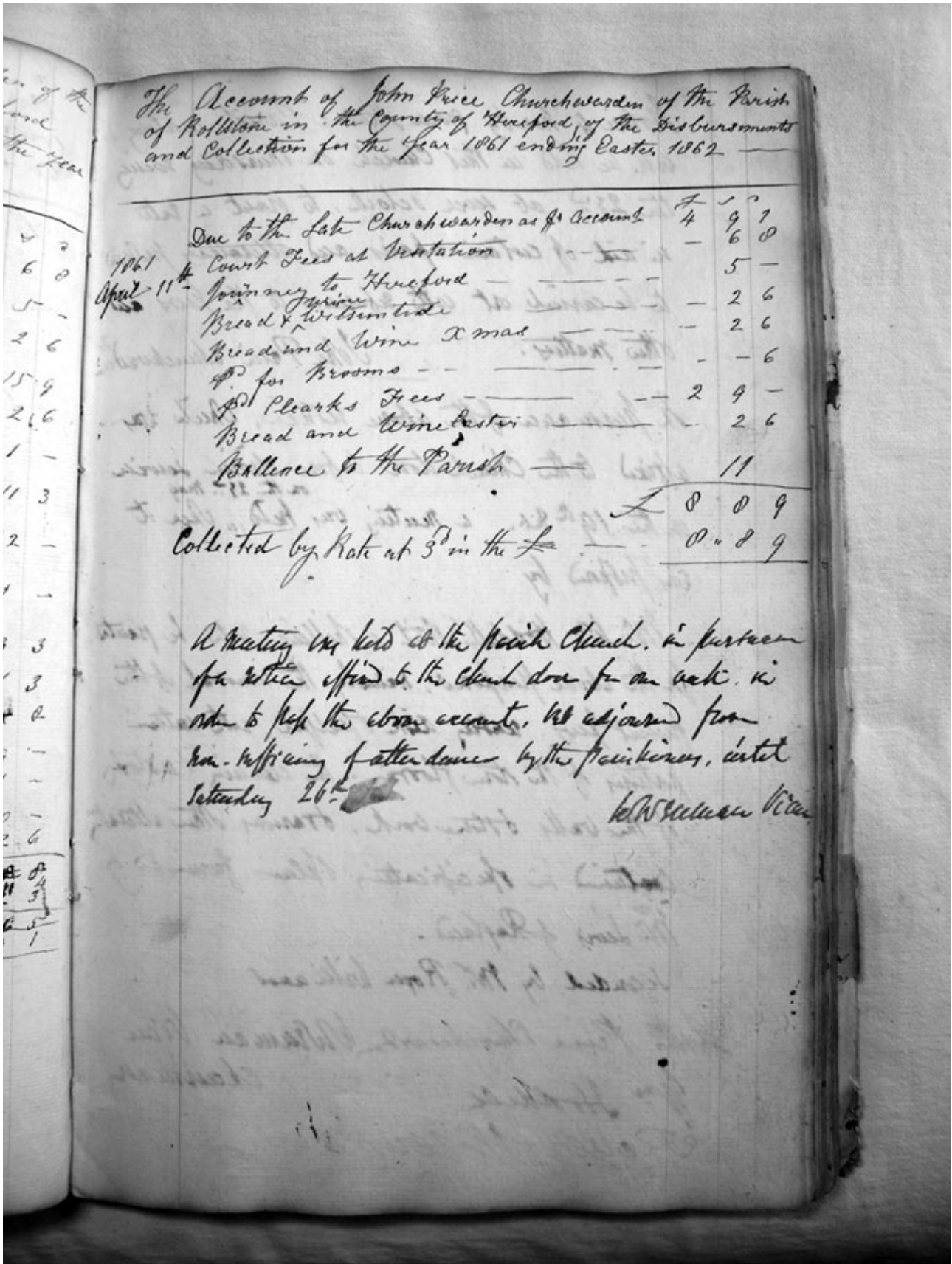

Notice is hereby given that a Parish meeting will be held in this Church on Thursday evening the 23rd at seven o'clock, to pass a vote in aid of certain repairs and alterations proposed to be carried out with reference to the pews and other matters.

In pursuance of the above notice, notice was affixed to the Church door before divine service on the 19th inst. a meeting was held ^{on the 23rd May} when it was proposed by

Mr. Wm. Hoddell that a shilling rate be granted for the above purposes, namely the removal of the present pews reading desk & pulpit, with certain portions of the stone flooring: the clearing & restoring of the walls & stone work, & various other alterations contained in specifications & plans furnished by Mr. Lewis of Hereford.
