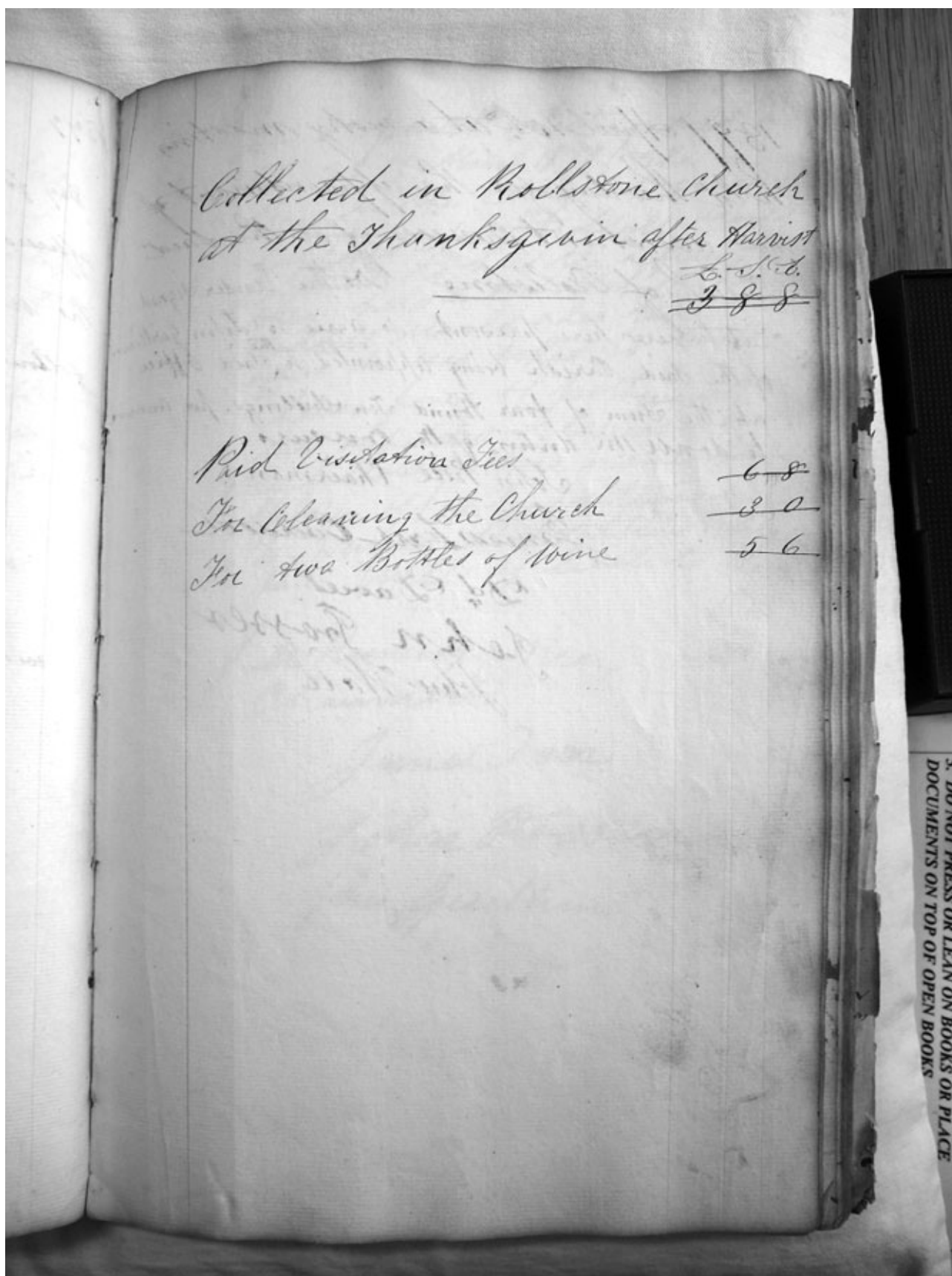

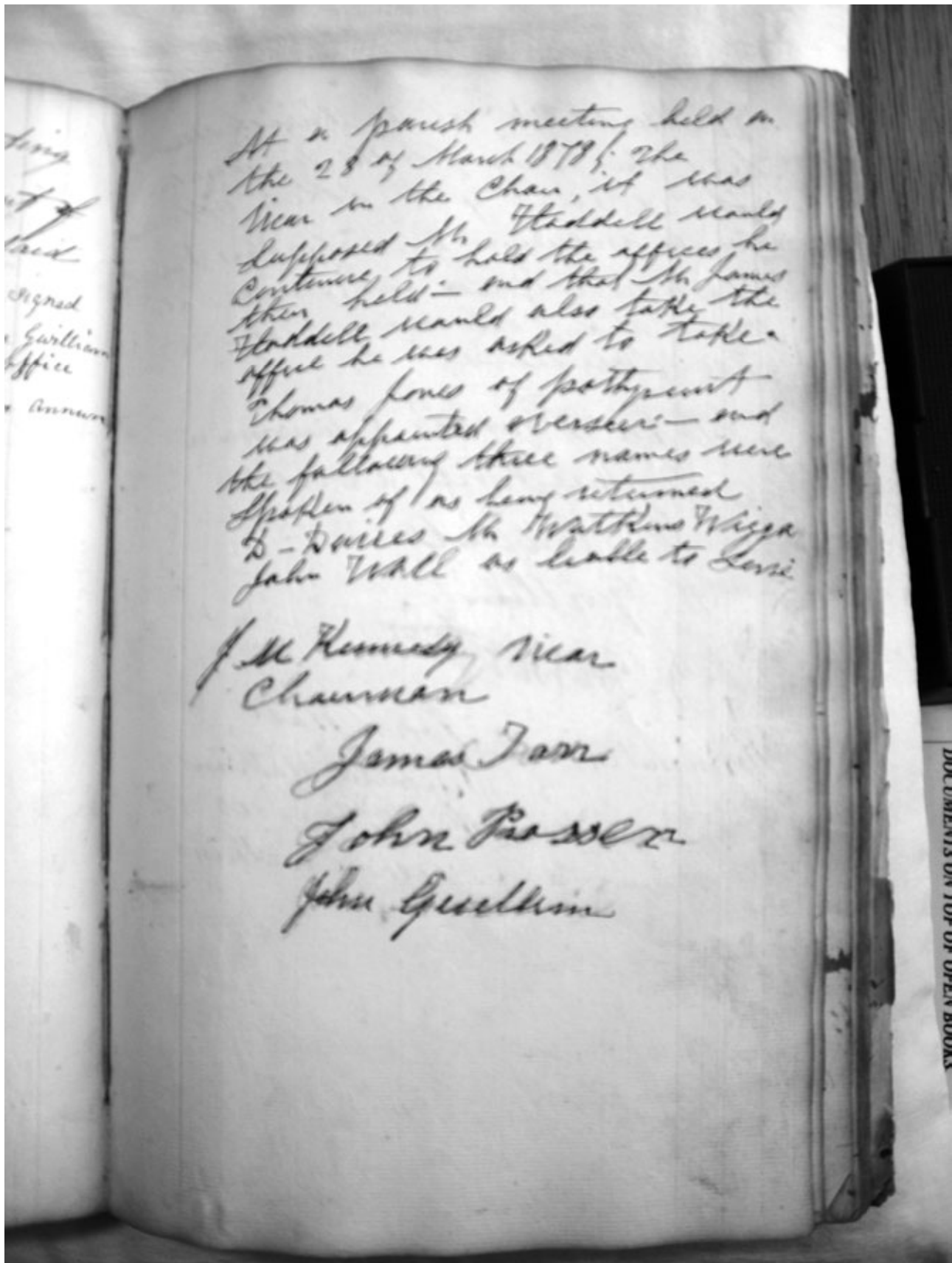

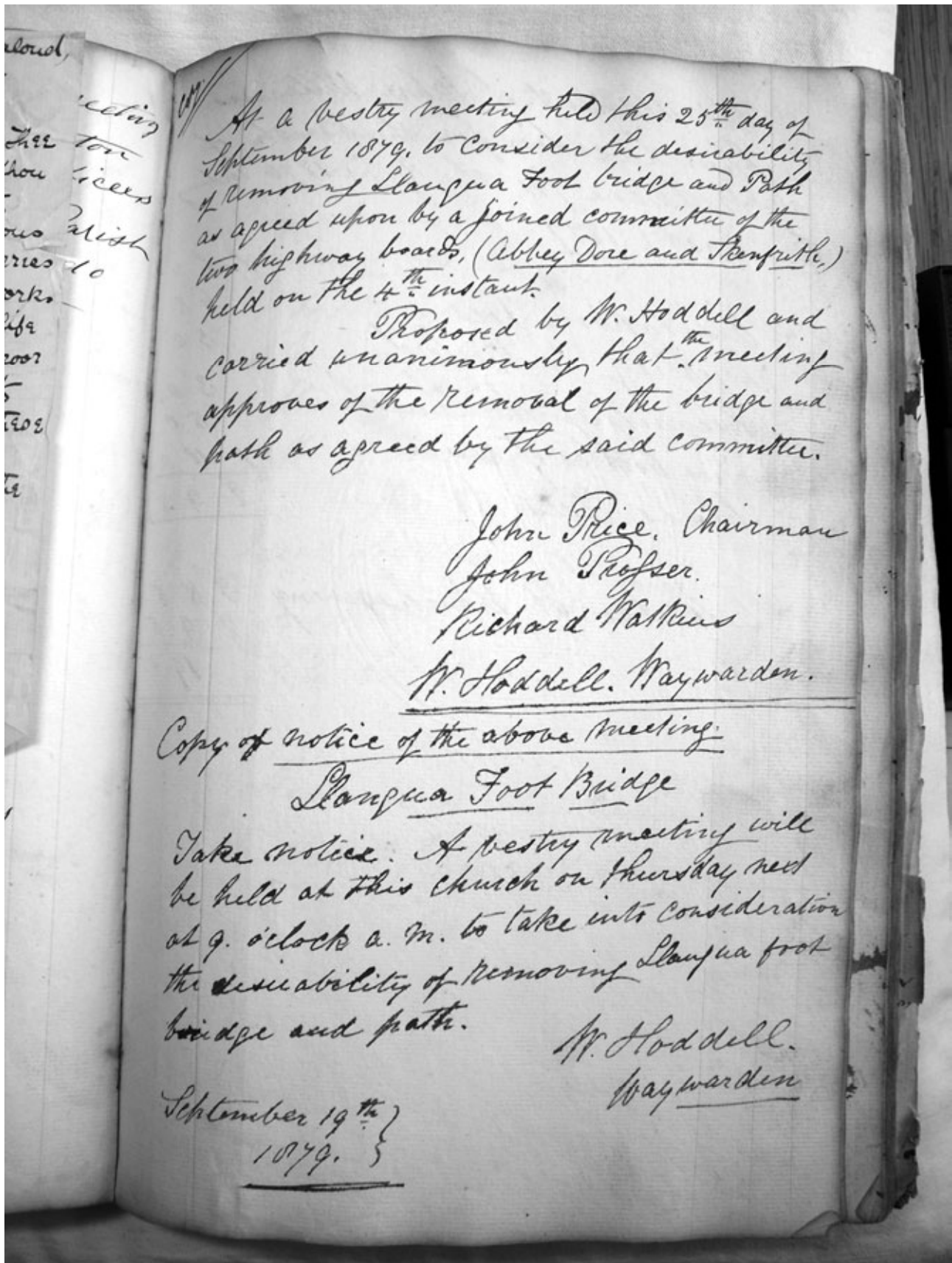
O Lord, our Heavenly Father, we give Thee
