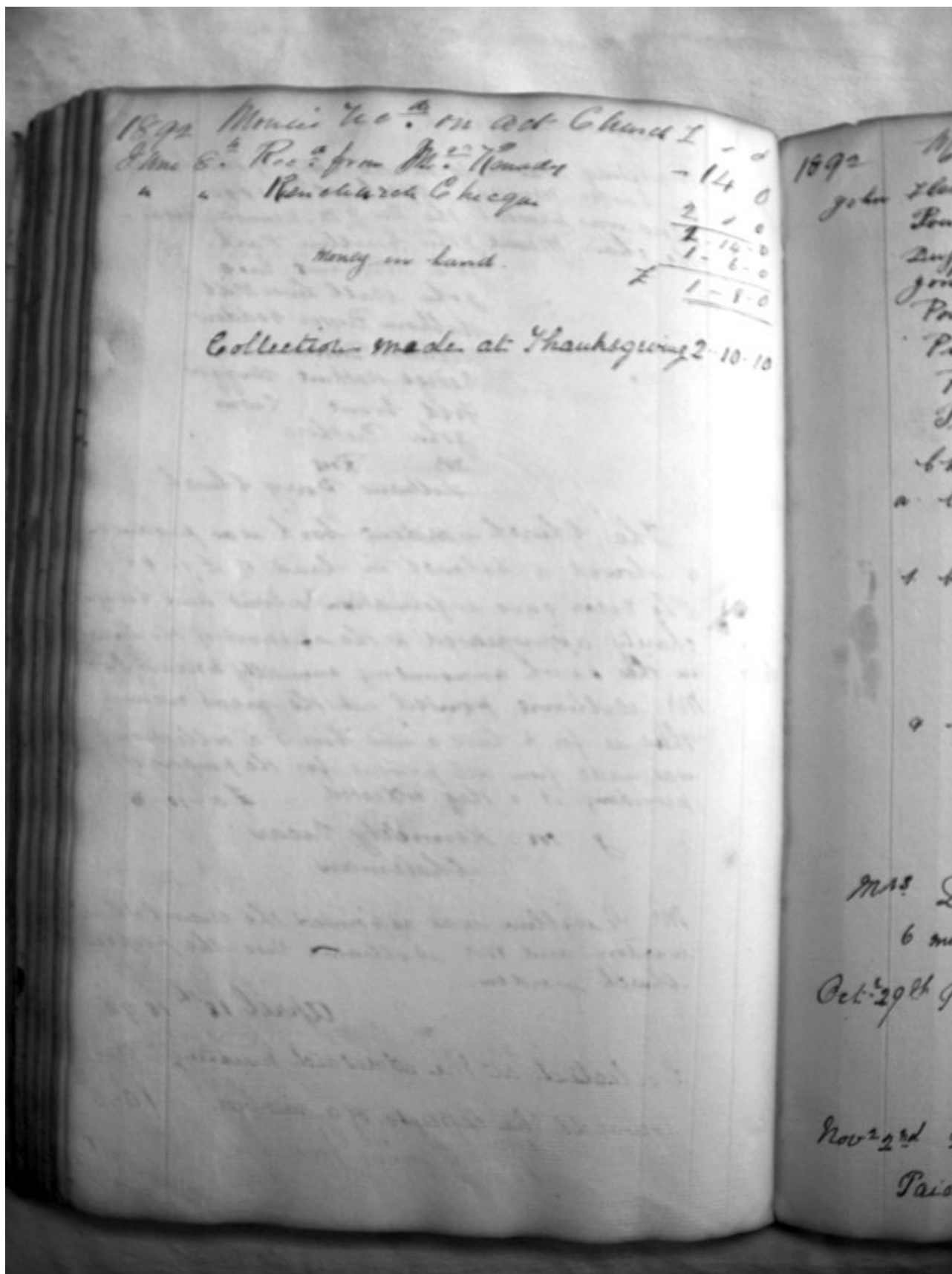

1893 April 3<sup>rd</sup> Parish of Redstone  
 a Vestry Meeting was held for the  
 purpose of Electing Church Wardens  
 for the ensuing Year.  
 It was proposed by Mr. Prosser  
 that Mr. John Williams Brown  
 should be the Rector's Vicar  
 Church Warden & Curate by Mr.  
 Prosser Redstone Court it was also  
 proposed by Mr. A. Evans that  
 Mr. George Williams Wye should  
 be the people's Church Warden & Curate  
 by Mr. Thos. Davies, Mill & Mr.  
 Johnson Old Vicarage it was also proposed  
 that there should be a Evening  
 service in place of an afternoon  
 for the summer months.

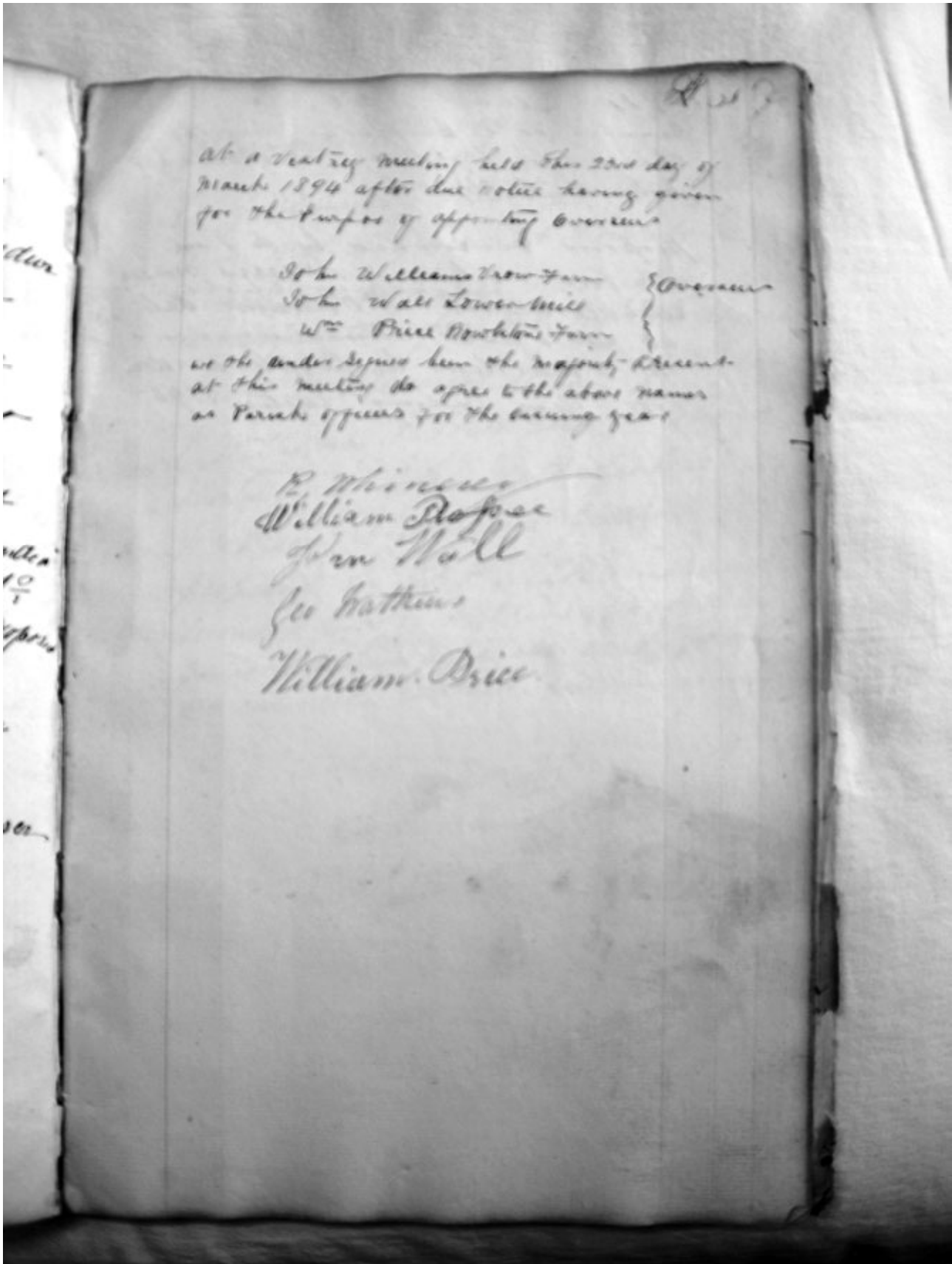
