Johnes Watkins holdeth freely to him & his heirs

Acre and a half lying in Llanthangell Ewley and  
pay therefore yearly to the Lords of the Manor of Ewyas  
Lacy on the part of the late Lord Hopton due 1<sup>o</sup> at the

of every tenant of the premisses

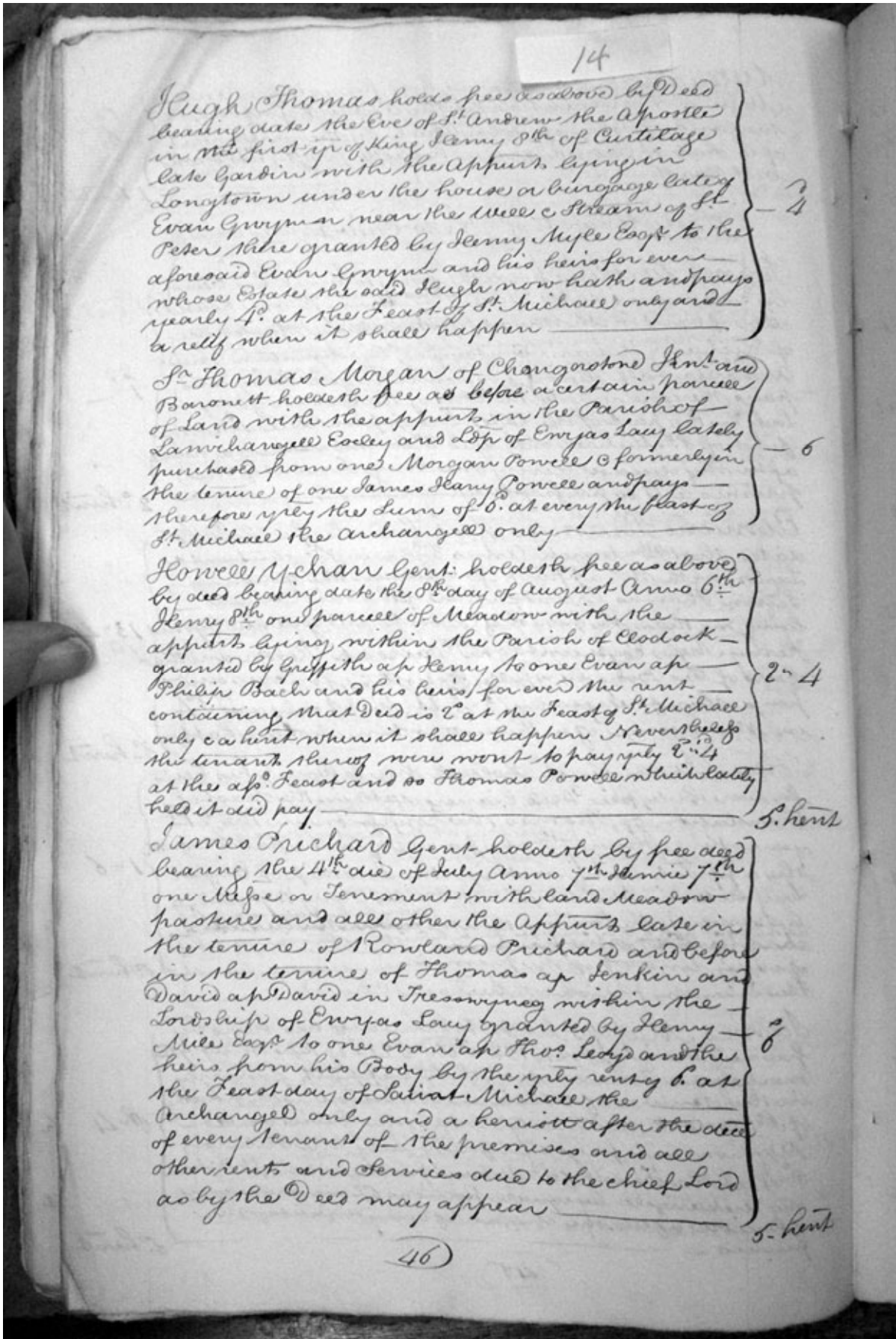

the Archangell by equal portions 6<sup>s</sup> in the name  
of heriott after the decease of every tenant of the  
premisses

 Evan Gwynn near the Well & Stream of St.  
 Peter there granted by Henry Myle Esq<sup>r</sup> to the  
 aforesaid Evan Gwynn and his heirs for ever  
 whose Estate the said Hugh now hath and pays  
 yearly 4<sup>s</sup>. at the Feast of St. Michael only and  
 a relly when it shall happen

St. Thomas Morean of Changanstone Kn<sup>t</sup> and  
 Baronett holdeth free as before a certain parcel  
 of Land with the appurts in the Parish of  
 Lanvicharell Escey and Ldp of Ewyas Lacy lately  
 purchased from one Morgan Powel & formerly in  
 the tenure of one James Henry Powel and pays  
 therefore yearly the sum of 6<sup>s</sup>. at every the feast of  
 St. Michael the Archangell only

Howell M. Chan Gent: holdeth free as above  
 by deed bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno 6<sup>th</sup>  
 Henry 8<sup>th</sup> one parcel of Meadow with the  
 appurts lying within the Parish of Clodock  
 granted by Griffith ap Henry to one Evan ap  
 Philip Bach and his heirs for ever the rent  
 containing that Deed is 2<sup>s</sup> at the Feast of St. Michael  
 only & a herit when it shall happen. Nevertheles  
 the tenants thereof were wont to pay yearly 2<sup>s</sup>. 4<sup>d</sup>  
 at the ap<sup>o</sup> Feast and so Thomas Powel truthfully  
 held it did pay

 bearing the 4<sup>th</sup> die of July Anno 7<sup>th</sup> Henrie 7<sup>th</sup>  
 one Mess or Tenement with land Meadow  
 pasture and all other the appurts late in  
 the tenure of Rowland Prichard and before  
 in the tenure of Thomas ap Jenkin and  
 David ap David in Tresswyney within the  
 Lordship of Ewyas Lacy granted by Henry  
 Myle Esq<sup>r</sup> to one Evan ap Tho<sup>s</sup> Ledy and the  
 heirs from his Body by the yearly rent of 6<sup>s</sup>. at  
 the Feast day of S<sup>t</sup>. Michael the  
 Archangell only and a heriott after the dece

Elinor George Widow holds free by Deed bearing date 10<sup>th</sup> die Feby Anno 10 Henric 8  
 one parcel of land with the appurts called  
 Lanveys Cont. there Acres Welsh measured lying  
 within the parish of Clodock granted by Henry  
 Miles Esq<sup>r</sup> unto one John Lywillm John Thomas  
 and to his heirs for ever which Estate was lately  
 in one John Thomas Parry by the rent of 2<sup>d</sup>  
 at the Feast of St. Michael only and 1<sup>d</sup> in the name  
 of a heriott when it shall happen } s. hunt

Anne Bacon Widow pays yearly to the Lords  
 of this Manor for certain Lands of hers in Clodock  
 2<sup>d</sup> at Michaelmas only but how the Lands are  
 bounded or by what they are ignorant } 2.

Hugh Charles pays yearly for his lands in  
 Lanveys at the Feast of St. Michael the  
 Archarges only 3<sup>d</sup> } 3

Thomas David pays yearly as above for his  
 lands in Michael Church late the Lands of  
 David Morgan 4<sup>d</sup> at Michas } 4

In the former Survey this is marked for an old  
 Meffe cis in Michael Church

Lewis Rees Harry pays yearly as above for his lands  
 in Lanveys the sum of 10<sup>s</sup> at Michas only } 10

John Parry of Dulas Esq<sup>r</sup> pays yearly at Michas  
 only the sum of 5<sup>s</sup> for his lands in Clodock  
 late the lands of Wm Lewis } 5

John Galls Gent. holds free to him and his  
 heirs one Meffe & one mill called Goytre Mill  
 in Walterstone & pays yearly at the Feast aforesaid 2<sup>d</sup>  
 and for a heriott double the rent } 2

This mill is now quite decayed.

James Pitt holds free by Deed certain Lands  
 called Gworloday ty back and other Lands in  
 Longtown & pays Morgans yearly at the Feast of Saint  
 Michael only half a Crown } 2-6

James Nicholls & Howell Mcham Gent. hold free  
 to them & their heirs by deed dated the last day of Jan<sup>y</sup> in the  
 of King Henric the 8<sup>th</sup> one tenement called Tyf up herid with  
 one Meadowe lands with the appurts formerly the lands of  
 Rowland Richd Henry the lying in or near the lands  
 called Cay Madock & and granted by Henry Miles Esq<sup>r</sup> to  
 Richard & David Britton and his heirs for ever whose  
 Estate in the premises the s<sup>r</sup> James & Howell now  
 have & pay yearly 6-8 at the Feast of Saint Michael only  
 and 5<sup>d</sup> in the name of a heriott when it shall happen } s. hunt
