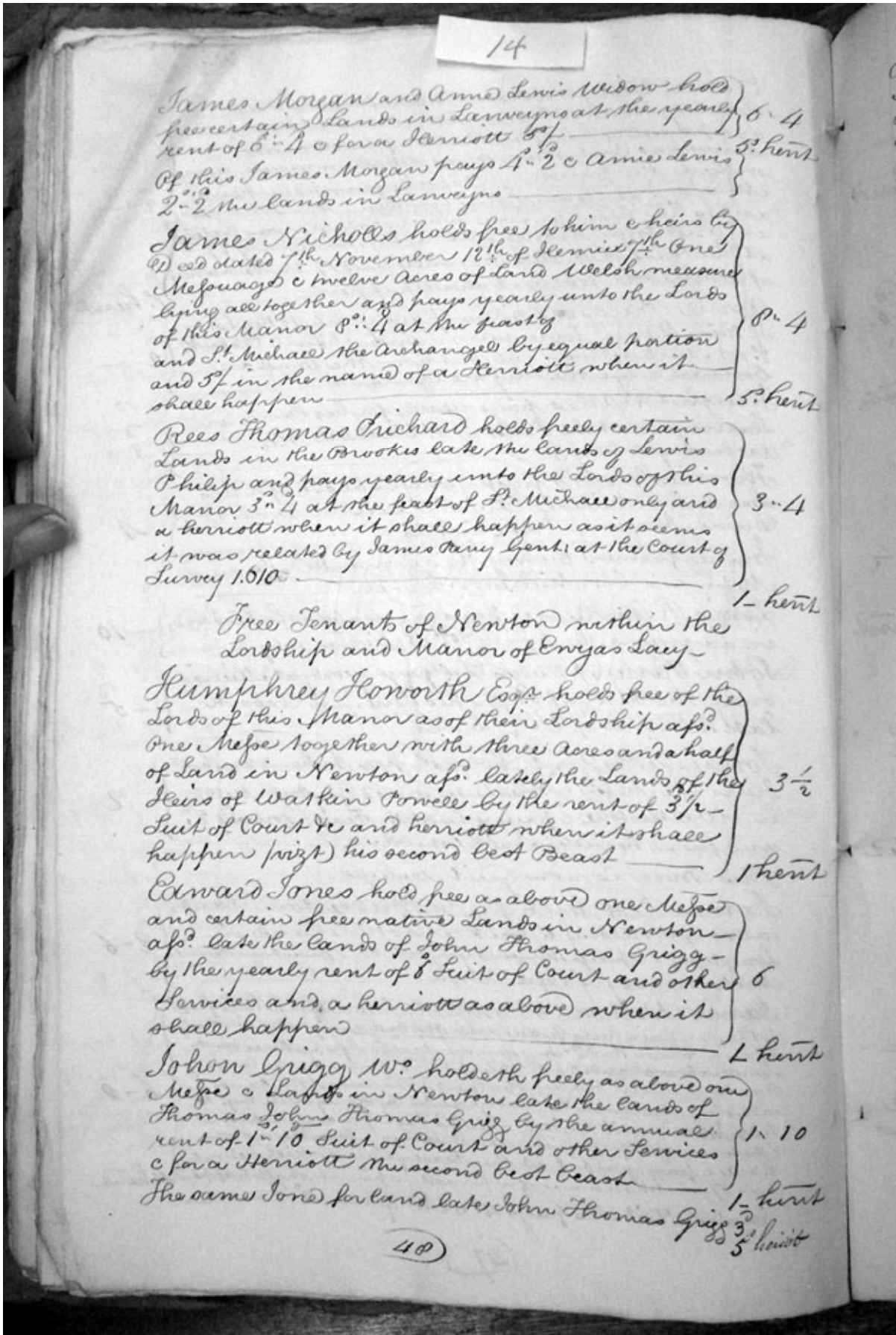

Thomas Beavan holdeth freely as above One Messuagie & Lands in Newton late the Lands of another Thomas Beavan by the yearly rent of 1^l 7^s Suit of Court &c and a herriott as above } 1^l 7^s

Charles Jenyns holds free as above two acres of Land in Newton late the lands of Sir Humphrey Baskerville by the yearly rent of 2^l Suit of Court &c and for a herriott 10^s } 2^l

Sibile Jenyns holds free as above One Messuagie and Lands in Newton aforesaid called Crumps lands by the yearly rent of 5^l Suit of Court &c and for a herriott her second best Beast } 5^l

James Rodd Esq^r for the moiety of a Messuagie at Leoydes } 1^l 10^s

The same James for a Messuagie and Land called Gwain Herbert } 5^l herriott

These two last belonging to an hospitall without Anne Gate Hereford } 1^l herriott

The Lands lately called Quarrelly lands divided in severall parcels as followeth

Henry Thomas Morgan holdeth free of the Lord of the Manor one Messuagie & Land with their appurtes late the Lands of Henry David Morgan Esq^r by the yearly rent of 1^l 2^s Suit of Court &c and for a herriott his second best Beast } 1^l 2^s

Jones Jenyns Sprinter holdeth free of the Lord one Messuagie & lands with the appurtes in Newton late the Lands of Thomas Jenyns by the yearly rent of Fourteen pence half penny Suit of Court and other Services & a herriott (vizt) the second best Beast } 1^l 2^s 1^h herriott

John Henry holdeth free as above One Messuagie & Lands with the appurtes in Newton late the Lands of Philip Morgan and Henry Thomas Esq^r by the yearly rent of 1^l 2^s Suit of Court &c and a herriott upon the division of the aforesaid Land (vizt) for the Messuagie &c his second best Beast and for the residue of the Land without a Messuagie 5^l } 1^l 2^s

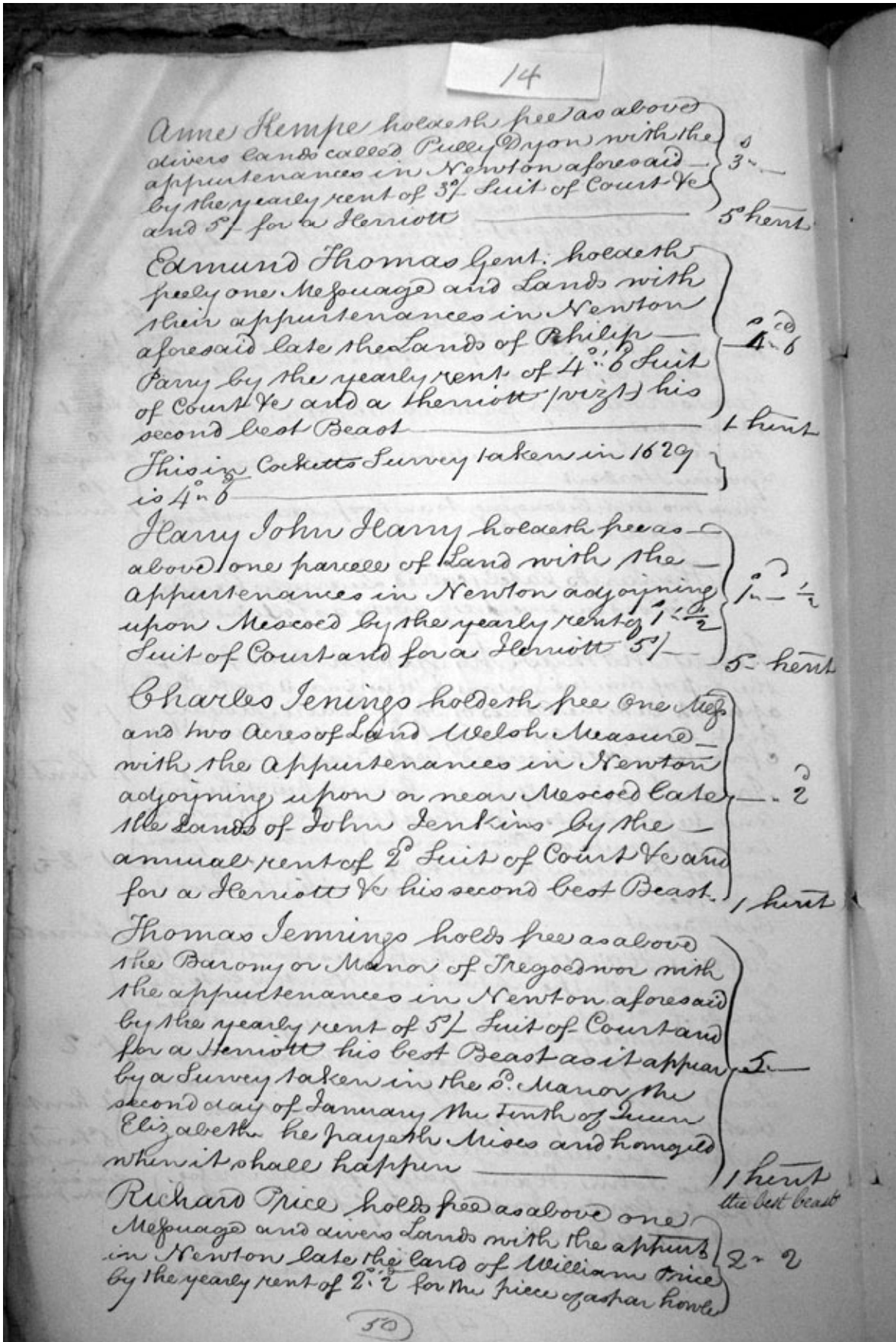
