That Mr John Lewis of Hollingwood by Indenture bearing date 29th of Septemr 1701
holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & one acre of land in Longtown one acre & half in Newton now in the possession of Mary Phillips wife one acre of land now in the possession of William Morgan Smith one acre & half now in the possession of James Evans one acre & half now in the possession of John Jones one acre & half now in the possession of James Parry & within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of Rowland Amy Elizabeth son & daughters of the said John Lewis all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the sum or summe of five Shillings all Lady day & minimes by equal portions And the sume of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Heriot att the death of every son dying seized or alienation of the premises

That Phillip Lewis son of John Lewis by Indenture bearing date 29th of Septemr 1702
holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage garden & two acres of land in Newton now in the possession of Maud Lewis widow within the jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Phillip, and his mother & John his wife all now living paying to the Lord of this Manor the sum or summe of one Shilling & six pence all Lady day & minimes by equal portions And the sume of two Shillings and six pence in the name of a Heriot att the death of every son dying seized or alienation of the premises

That William Lloyd of Longtown by Indenture bearing date 29th of Septemr 1701 held
of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & half acre of land now in the possession of Thomas Lewis one acre of land in Newton now in the possession of the sd Thomas Lewis within the jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the sd William Lloyd his wife & William their son all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the sum or summe of one Shilling all Lady day & minimes by equal portions And the sume of one Shilling in the name of a Heriot att the death of every son dying seized or alienation of the premises This Lease was assigned to the said Thomas Lewis.

That Walter Williams of Newton by Indenture bearing date 29th of Septemr 1701 holdeth
of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage one acre & half of land now in the possession of the said Walter Williams within the jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Walter Williams himself his wife John the son of William Lloyd all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the sum or summe of one Shilling all Lady day & minimes by equal portions And the sume of one Shilling in the name of a Heriot att the death of every son dying seized or alienation of the premises

That John Thomas of Newlyn by Indenture bearing date 29th of Septemb^r 1701 held of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & garden & four acres of land now in the possession of Joseph Roberts within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said John Thomas Ann his wife and John Roberts Son of Joseph Roberts of Hollingwood now deceased paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of one Shilling six pence at Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions and the sume of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every son dying seized or estimation of the premises This Lease was designed to the sd Joseph Roberts for the lesse aforesd

That M^r John Lewis of Hollingwood by Inde^r bearing date 29th of Septemb^r 1702 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of John Jones within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of Thomas William & Elizabeth Sons & daughter of the sd John Lewis and his wife now deceased paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of six pence at Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions and the sd John Lewis holdeth half an acre of land now in the possession of James Parry for his wife aforesd paying no more or less than what is before mentioned and paying six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every son dying seized or estimation of the premises

That Thomas Lewis of Weston by Inde^r bearing date 29th of Septemb^r 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of the sd Thomas Lewis & Maria Lewis within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the sd Thomas Lewis John Son of Wm Lewis of Longtown & Elizabeth daughter of John Lewis of Hollingwood all now deceased paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of one Shilling at Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions and the sume of one Shilling in the name of a Heriot at the death of every son dying seized or estimation of the premises

That Jane Morgan of Longtown Widdow by Inde^r bearing date 29th of Septemb^r 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & one acre & half of land now in the possession of the sd Jane Morgan within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of William Lewis & Mary his Sons & daughter one now deceased paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of one Shilling & six pence at Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions and the sume of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every son dying seized or estimation of the premises

That William Lewis of Longtown by Inde^r bearing date 29th of Septemb^r 1701 held of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of Wm Lewis his wife & John his daughter both now deceased paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of two Shillings & six pence at Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions and the sume of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every son dying seized or estimation of the premises



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That Thomas James of Longtown by Inde bearing date 29th of September 1701 held of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of Jane James widow within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Thomas James and his wife Jane & James party only two now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of two shillings att Lady day & minnows by equal portions And the sume of two shillings in the name of a Hierarchy all the death of every person dying seized or estimation of the premises

That John Phillips of Longtown by Inde bearing date 29th of January 1692 held of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of Mary Phillips widow within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said John James Phillips & Mary Phillips son & daughter of Moses Phillips one now living in mesfied two gone beyond her paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of two shillings att Lady day & minnows by equal portions

That Richard Jones of Kingstone by Inde bearing date 29th of September 1701 held of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of the said Richard & Thomas Jones within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Richard & Thomas & Richard sons of the said Richard Jones all of them now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of two shillings & six pence att Lady day & minnows by equal portions and the sume of two shillings & six pence in the name of a Hierarchy all the death of every person dying seized or estimation of the premises

That Katherine Lloyd of Newton by Inde bearing date 29th of September 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of the said Katherine Lloyd within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Katherine Edward & Mary her son & daughter all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of six pence att Lady day & minnows by equal portions And the sume of six pence in the name of a Hierarchy all the death of every person dying seized or estimation of the premises

That John Lewis of Newton by Inde bearing date 29th of September 1702 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of the said John Lewis within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said John Lewis his wife Margery his son & daughter of Bartholomew two now & two & six pence now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or sume of one shilling att Lady day & minnows by equal portions And one shilling in the name of a Hierarchy all the death of every person dying seized or estimation of the premises

Cottage & two acres of land now in his possession within the Jurisdiction
of this Court
