That Mr. John Lewis of Hattinwood by Indentures bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & one acre of land in Longton one acre & half in Newton now in the possession of Mary Phillips widow. one acre of land now in the possession of William Morgan Smith one acre & half now in the possession of James Thomas one acre & half now in the possession of John Jones & one acre & half now in the possession of James Parry & within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of Rowland Ann & Elizabeth Son & daughters of the said John Lewis all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or Summs of five Shillings all Lady day & within by equal portions And the Summs of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Herriott all the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises

That Phillip Lewis son of Steevens by Indentures bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1702 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage garden & two acres of land in Newton now in the possession of Grand Lewis widow within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Phillip Grand his Mother & Johan his wife all now living paying to the Lord of this Manor the rent or Summs of one Shilling & six pence all Lady day & within by equal portions And the Summs of two Shillings and six pence in the name of a Herriott all the death of every dying seized or Alienation of the premises

That William Lloyd of Longton by Indentures bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & half an acre of land now in the possession of Thomas Lewis & one acre of land in Newton now in the possession of the said Thomas Lewis within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said William Lloyd Martha his wife & William their son all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or Summs of one Shilling all Lady day & within by equal portions And the Summs of one Shilling in the name of a Herriott all the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises, this Lease was assigned to the said Thomas Lewis.

That Walter William of Newton by Indentures bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage one acre & half of land now in the possession of the said Walter W<sup>m</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Walter Williams Mary his wife & John the son of William Lloyd all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or Summs of one Shilling all Lady day & within by equal portions And the Summs of one Shilling in the name of a Herriott all the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises



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That John Thomas of Newton by Indenture bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage garden & four acres of land now in the possession of Joseph Roberts within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said John Thomas Ann his wife and John Robert son of the said John Thomas all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or summe of four Shillings all Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions And the summe of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises. This Lease was assigned to the said Joseph Roberts for the term aforesaid

That M<sup>r</sup> John Lewis of Holsingwood by Indenture bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1702 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of John Jones within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of Thomas William & Elizabeth sons & daughter of the said John Lewis and they now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or summe of five pence all Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions And the said John Lewis holdeth half an acre of land now in the possession of James Parry for if he was a freeholder paying no more rent than what is before mentioned And paying six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises

That Thomas Lewis of Newton by Indenture bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & two acres of land now in the possession of the said Thomas Lewis & Ann Lewis within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of the said Thomas Lewis John son of W<sup>m</sup> Lewis of Longtown & Elizabeth daughter of John Lewis of Holsingwood all now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or summe of one Shilling all Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions And the summe of one Shilling in the name of a Heriot at the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises

That Jane Morgan of Longtown widow by Indenture bearing date 29<sup>th</sup> of Septemb<sup>r</sup> 1701 holdeth of the Lord of this Manor one Cottage & one acre & half of land now in the possession of the said Jane Morgan within the Jurisdiction of this Court for the lives of William David & Mary her sons & daughter and they now living paying yearly to the Lord of this Manor the rent or summe of one Shilling & six pence all Lady day & Michaelmas by equal portions And the summe of two Shillings & six pence in the name of a Heriot at the death of every person dying seized or Alienation of the premises

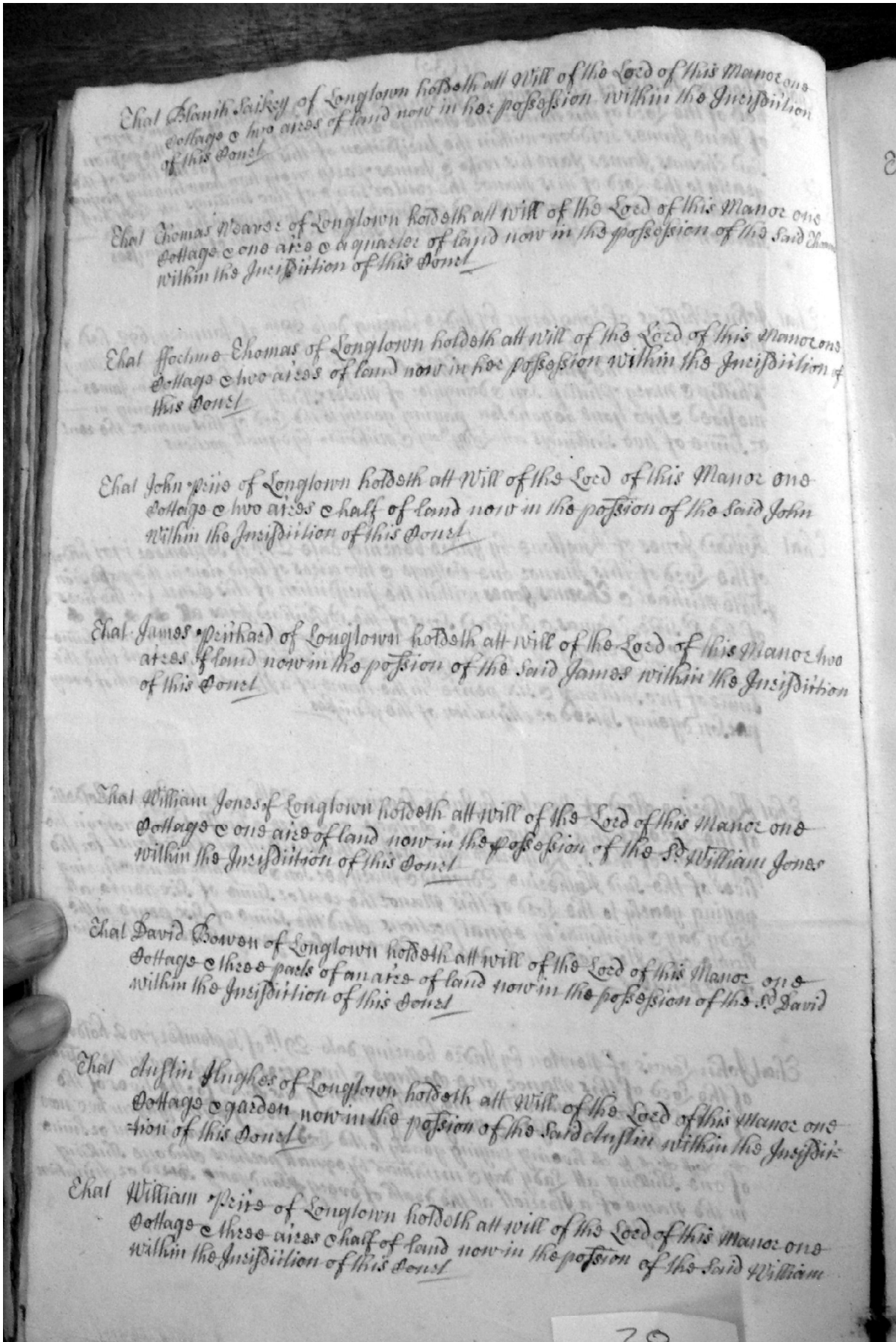
