 & daughter of the sd Joseph Mary William are now hiring dayling yearly to the lord of this manor for the same the rent or sum of one shilling att which only besides twelve shillings fine pd to the lord upon granting the said lease wth pmisses are made & bounded as followeth.

That Elizabeth Phillips by indenture bearing the same date holdeth of the lord of this manor a cottage garden & parcell of land now in the possession of lying within
 the jurisdiction of this court of the yearly value of for the hires of Margarott
 Warkins, Elizabeth James Williams & James Powell now hiring dayling
 yearly to the lord of this manor for the same the rent or sum of one shilling att which only besides ten shillings fine already pd to the lord of this manor upon granting of the said lease wth pmisses are made & bounded as followeth.

That Jane Thwre doted now Morgan Thwre her son ~~Richard~~ by indenture bearing the same date holdeth of the lord of this manor a cottage & four arres of land now in the possession of the sd Morgan lying within the jurisdiction of this court of the yearly value of for the hires of the sd Jane Morgan & Richard her sons both now
 hiring dayling yearly to the lord of this manor for the same the rent or sum of one shilling att which only besides twenty shillings fine already pd to the lord of this manor upon granting of the sd lease wth pmisses are made & bounded as followeth.
