That Job Dowell by copy of Court Roll bearing date the 22^d Apr 1703 Holdeth of the Lord of this Manor all the will of the said according to the custom of this Manor six acres of Customary land with measure now in the possession of the said Job Dowell lying within the jurisdiction of this Court of the yearly value of $\text{£}10$ for the hives of Samuel his son Samuel the son of Rowland Mathews & Rowland Jennings all now living saying these four yearly to the Lord of this Manor for the same the rent or sum of two shillings and three pence all winter only & five shillings in hives of a horse upon the death or surrender of the son. Besides eleven pounds fine already pd to the Lord of this Manor upon granting of the said copy. The parcels of this copy are as followeth viz^t One acre & a half of meadow & wood 18 acres another piece of pasture below that 10 acres another part by it & a piece of drails by the way side viz^t 10 acres & 100 paces bounded as followeth East the land leading from Middle Mead toward Quarrelley South & West by the poor lands in possession of viz^t North by a land leading from Mead toward Nain's Herd.

That Robert Jennings doted now David Sims in right of his who is sister & heir to the said Robert by copy of Court Roll bearing date the 29th day of April 1680 Holdeth of the Lord of this Manor all the will of the said according to the custom of this Manor six acres of Customary land with measure called One harrow now in the possession of Thomas & Edward lying within the jurisdiction of this Court of the yearly value of $\text{£}10$ for the hives of the said Robert John Jennings the son of Rowland Jennings doted & David Sims son of the said David Sims all now living but the said Robert Jennings saying yearly to the Lord of this Manor for the same the rent or sum of one shilling & six pence all winter only & five shillings upon the death or surrender of the son. Besides fine already pd to the Lord of this Manor upon granting the said copy. The parcels of this copy are as followeth viz^t One piece of rough land partly drails partly pasture & partly wood land in all abt. 16 acres & 100 paces bounded as followeth North West to the land leading from Mead to St. Margarette & on all other parts to the lands of the heirs of Rowland Mathews of the New house doted.

The parcels of this copy are as followeth One plankin drails 16 acres One best drails & pasture 12 acres One drails & meadow 15 acres One hill meadow & pasture 15 acres One washed drails & meadow 10 acres bounded North by John Smith's land & the ever Dulas on all other parts by lower Mead more wooded & meadow 15 acres One fork drails & pasture & wood 11 acres One wooded gale meadow 4 acres One Staggins drails & wood 6 acres One green pasture 17 acres One green drails & meadow 9 acres One 42 ewen pasture 10 acres bounded North by the Quarrelley land & John Smith's East lower Mead South & West the lands of John Jones Esq in South to David Dowell more One block drails 4 acres surrounded round by lower Mead.

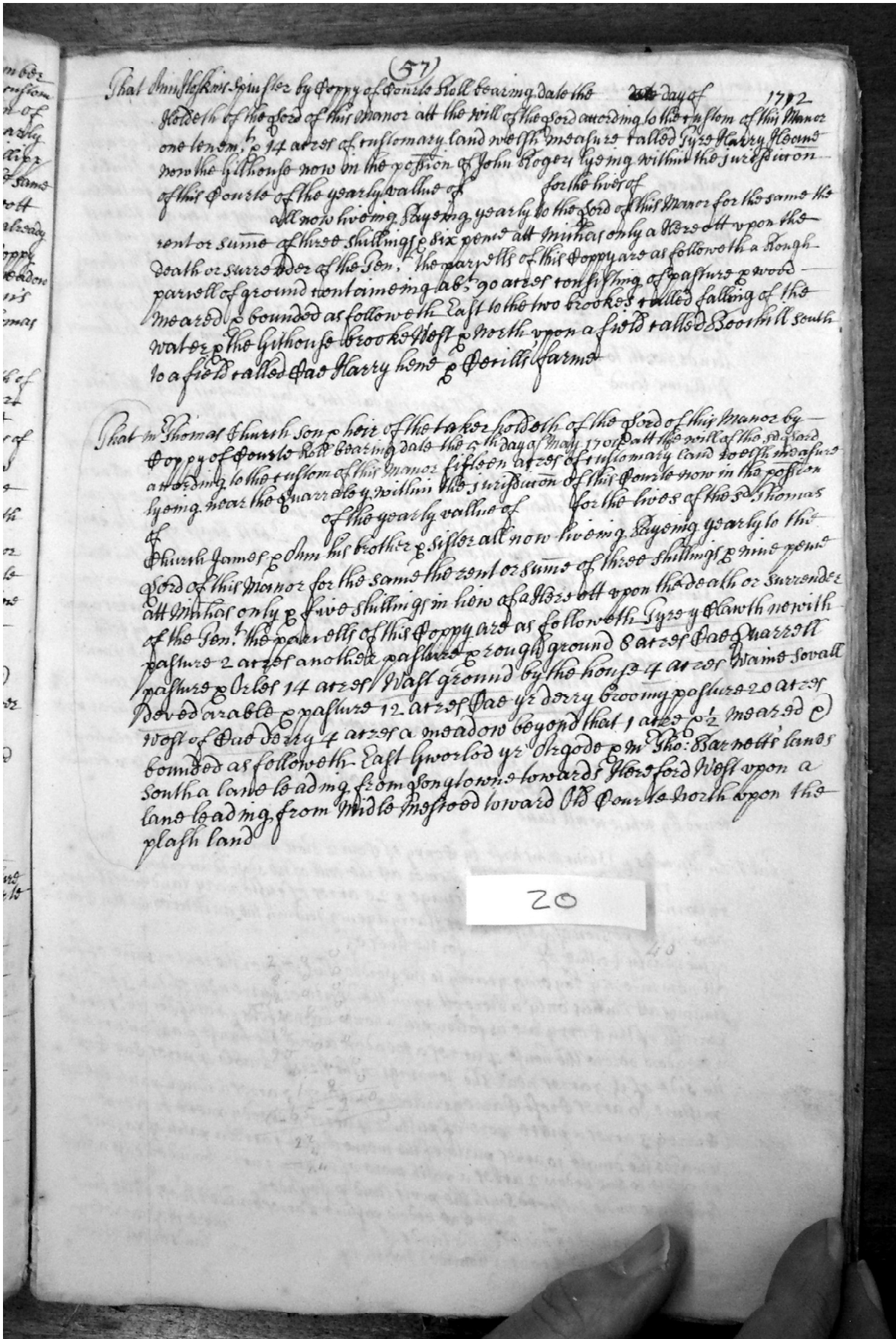
