We the Jurors Sworn and Impannell'd to Enquire for our Sovereign Lord the King & the Lord of the Manner Do Report as followeth

We Present that Thomas Griffiths of the Comb in the Parish of Delatuburk Tenant of this Manner who was Suit & Service to this Court & hath been duly summoned to Appear at this Court as Appear by the Oath of the Bayleiff of this Manner That he hath made Default & forsook his Default We Assess him in the sum of three Shillings & four Pence

And the said Afforors Appeared at Eighteen Pence

Also We Present that Thomas Griffiths for neglecting and refusing to set up a Gate & amend his Hedge between a certain Parcel of Land in Parish of the S. Thomas Griffiths called Gas Meadow & a Parcel of Land of Mr. John Druce of Uwishay called Ewan Gledeor all in the said Manner of Uwishay by means whereof the S. John Druce has had several Trespasses done in his Land in the said Manner & we lay a Penalty of 13. 4. to be levied upon the said Thomas Griffiths Goods & Chattels in case he neglects to set up the said Gate or repair the said Hedge on or before the second day of February next And that the S. John Druce do certify the Performances thereof on like Penalty

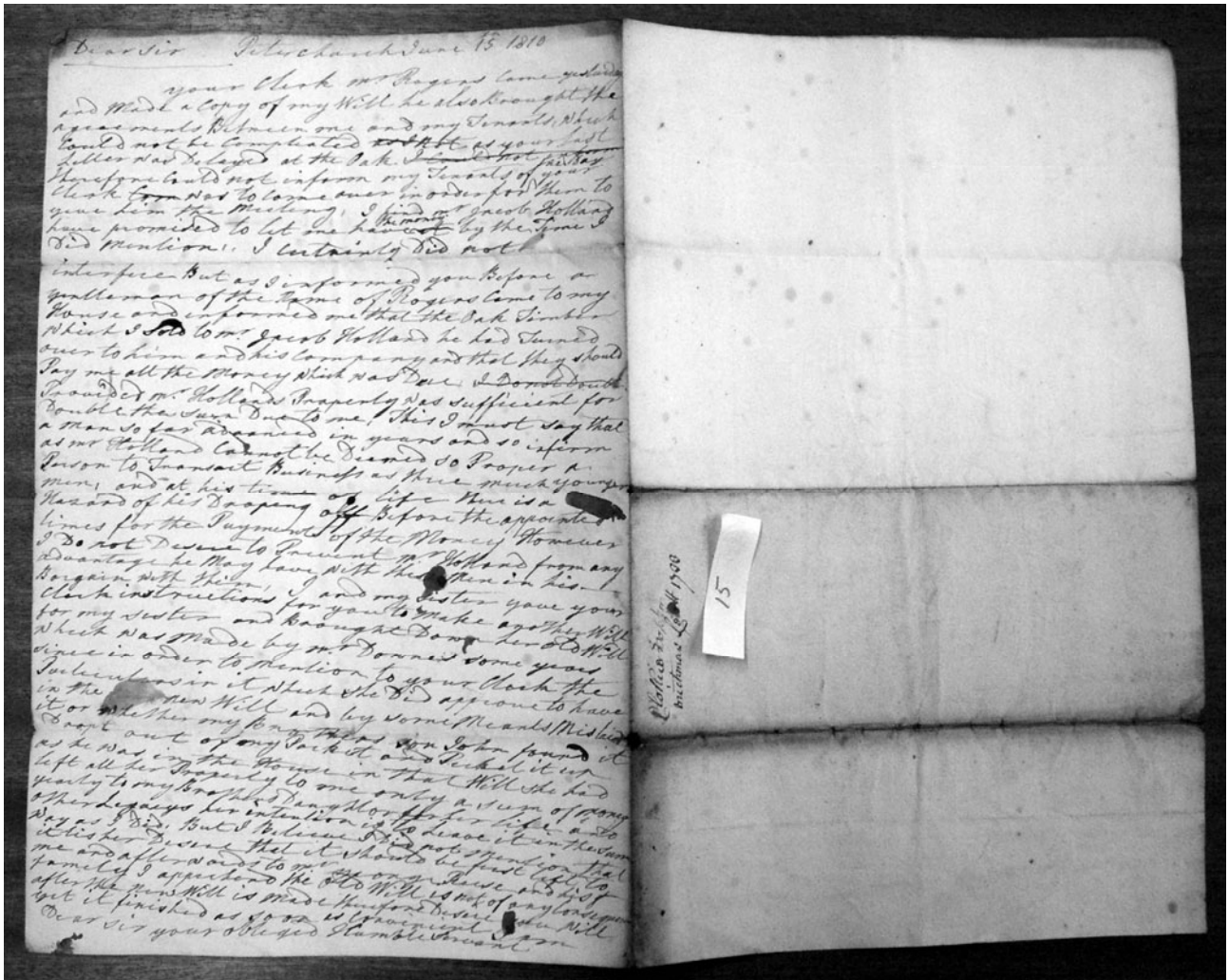
Also we lay the S. Thomas Griffiths under the same Penalty if he does not repair the Hedge between a parcel of Land in Parish of S. Thos Griffiths called Wm Williams Meadow And a Piece of Land called Dinet in Parish of Richd Gronow in the manner aforesaid on or before the 2. day of Feb. next And that the S. Richd Gronow do certify the repairs thereof under the said Penalty of 13. 4.

Also We Present that John Watkins late of Michael Church Esq. Esq. a Tenant of the Manner of Clothie Hopkin holds certain lands in Michael Church afores. in the Manner of Clothie Hopkin by lease for five hundred Years at the rate of three Shillings & four Pence payable yearly at Christmas And that he is in Arrear the sum of Thirty Shillings for nine years next received by the S. Lewis Jones and in Arrear since Christmas last And we lay him under the Penalty of Thirty nine Shillings to be levied on his Goods and Chattels in case he neglects to pay the same within the space of thirty Days next after the receipt

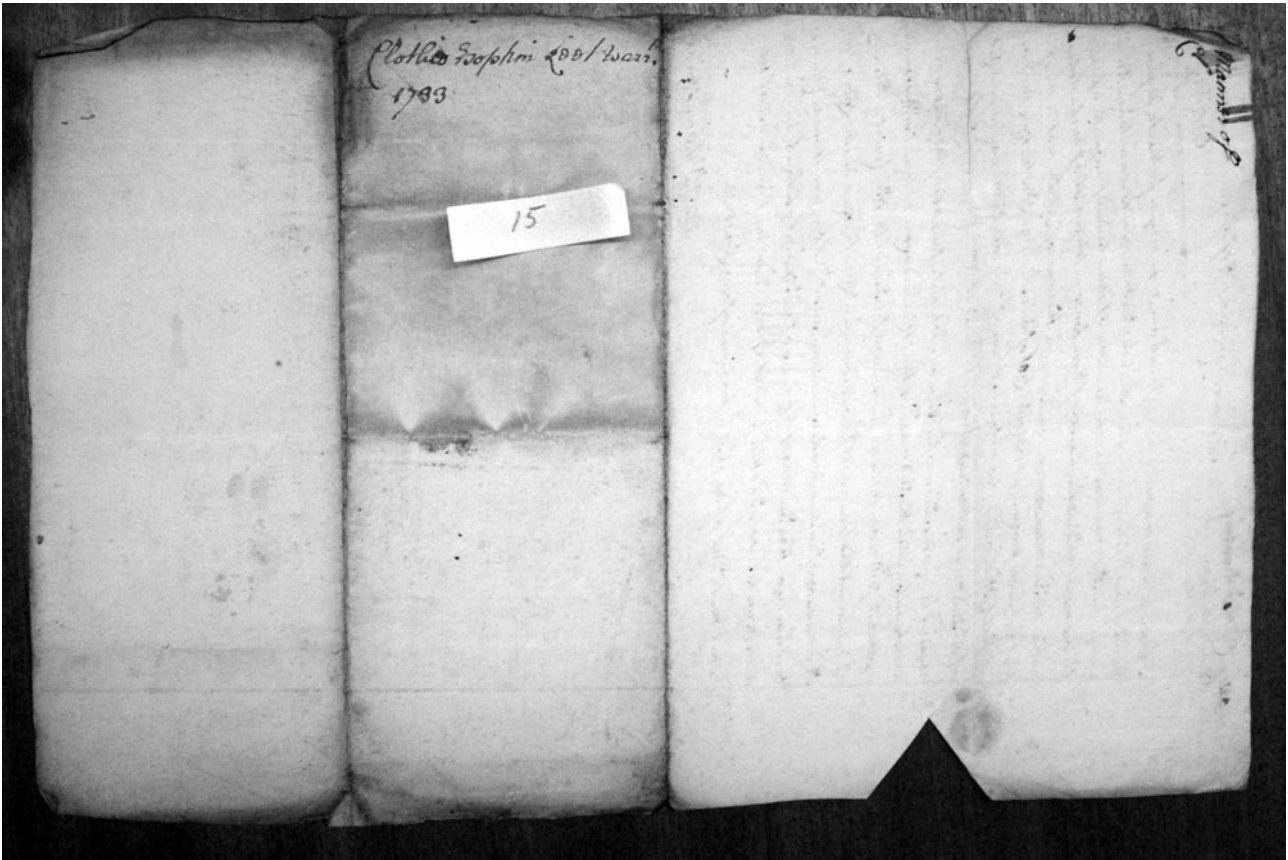
We the Jurors sworn to enquire for our Sovereign Lord the King and the Lady of the said manor present as followeth
