And the said Lord by his Steward according to the Custom of the said Manor pursuant to such Surrender is pleased And Doth by these presents grant unto the said Philip Parry and Sibile his wife All the aforesaid promises with the appurtenances To have and to hold the said promises with the appurtenances unto the said Philip Parry and Sibile his wife their heirs and assigns for and during the Prospective Lives of the said Philip Parry Sibile his wife and Philip their son and the Lips of the longest liver of them according to the Custom of the said Manor Yielding and paying therefor yearly to the said Lord his heirs and assigns during the said Term the Annual rent of Two Shillings and Six pence of lawful money of great Britain at the Feast day of Saint Michael the Arch angel only and an horriot as it happens Vizt. at the Decease or Surrender of every Tenant of the said promises And also doing suit of Court and all other Customs and Services which the rest of the Customary Tenants of the said Manor do or ought of right to do Provided always that neither the said Philip Parry nor Sibile his wife nor their Heirs shall let out of their hands the promises aforesaid or any part thereof to any person or persons whatsoever without License from the said Lord his heirs or assigns on pain of forfeiting the whole term Interest Estate aforesaid And the aforesaid Philip Parry hath given to the said Lord as a fine for such Estate so had the sum of seven pound of Lawfull British money and hath done Fealty and is admitted Tenant of the said promises
