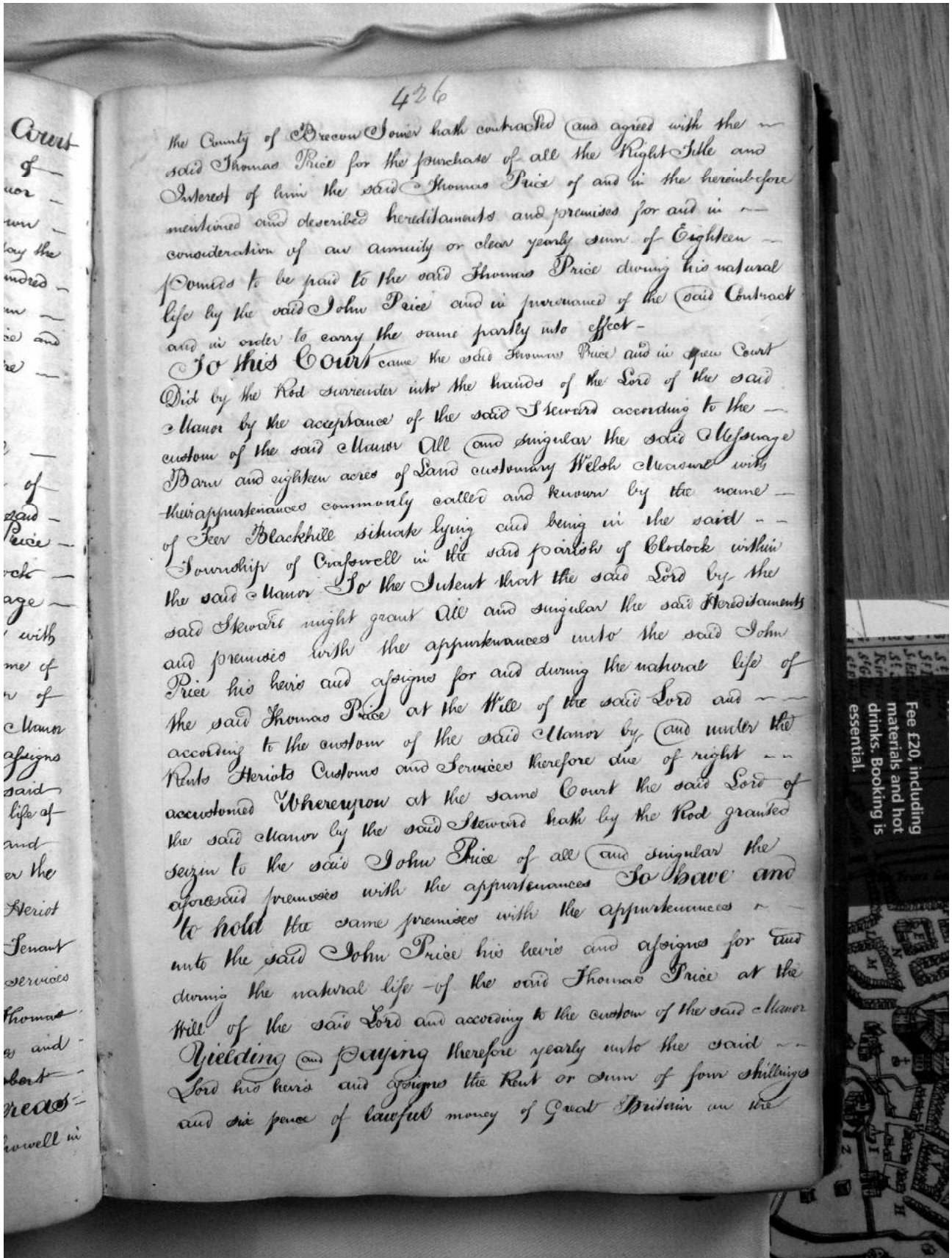

 in the County of Hereford Farmer All that Messuage
 Barn and eighteen acres of Land Customary Welsh Measure with
 their appurtenances commonly called and known by the name of
 Deer Blackhill situate lying and being in the Township of
 Craswell in the said Parish of Clodock within the said Manor
 To hold unto the said Thomas Price his heirs and assigns
 for and during the respective natural lives of him the said
 Thomas Price and Robert Price (his Brother) and the life of
 the longest liver of them at the Will of the said Lord and
 according to the custom of the said Manor at and under the
 yearly rent of four shillings and six pence and an Heriot
 of Five shillings at the decease or Surrender of every Tenant
 of the said premises and all other customs and services
 therefore due and of right accustomed And the said Thomas
 Price was thereupon admitted Tenant of the said premises and
 did to the Lord fealty And whereas the said Robert
 Price has long since departed this life And whereas
