and John Jones son of John Jones of the parish  
of Kentechurch in the County of Hereford Farmer  
under and by virtue of a Grant dated the  
seventeenth day of January One thousand  
eight hundred and forty six and for the  
consideration mentioned in a certain Indenture  
of Mortgage bearing date the twenty ninth day  
of May One thousand eight hundred and  
fifty four and made between the said John  
Watkins of Blackhill of the one part and  
John Watkins of Treowen in the parish of  
Llangattock Vibon Avel in the County  
of Monmouth Farmer of the other part whereby  
the said hereditaments and premises were  
charged by way of Mortgage with the  
payment of the sum of Four hundred pounds  
and interest and which said Indenture  
is marked with the proper advaloram duty  
in respect of the said money did by the said  
Surrender into the hands of the said Lord by
