




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Randolph Trafford severally and successively accdg to thr respive seniorotoes in tail general with divers readrs over AND by para 20 of sd Will it was declared that it shd be lawful at any time or times during the lives or life of any person to whom as estate for his or her life was thrby limited or within 21 yrs next after death of the last survivor of them for the sd Charles Guy Trafford and Sir Edward Hopton and Henry Edmund (14th) Viscount (thrin called Henry Edmund Butler but thriner called Lord Mountgerret] and the survivors and survivor of them and the exors or admors of such survivor to sell or exchange the Herefordshire estate or any part or parts thof in manner thrin mentioned and to lay out the moys arising under or by such power of sale and exchange in the pohes of other heredits And by para 68 of the sd Will it was provided that if the Trees for time being for any of the ppses of the sd Will or any of them shd die or be desirous of being disched then and in every such case it shd be lawful for the surviving or continuing Tree for the same ppses by any writing under his hand and seal to nominate and substitute any one or more person dying or being desirous of being discharged as efsd AND it was also declared that the so powers might if that fit be so exercised that there shd be deifferent sets of trees for the different ppses of sd W111 AND by para 70 of sd Will Henry Edmund (13th) Viscount Mountgarret and sd Charles Guy Trafford and Lord Mountgarret were apptd Exors of sd Will

ALL and Singular the heredits parlars whrof were specified in Schle thunder writtem and delineated so far as same were capable of delineation on plan thrto annexed and all other (if any) messages lands tenements rents rent charges advowsons and heredits wh then by any means formed part of the Herefordshire Estate subjt to the limitations of ad Will and Godls were vested in trees in fee simple

2. AND that Trees shd stand possessed of ad heredits and premes upon the trusts and sibjt to powrs and provens upon and subjt to wh under the settlemt created by ad Will and Codls the same ought from time to time to be held



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3. AND that the Trees were the Trees of the Settlement for ppses of Settled Land Act 1925.

4. AND that the power to appt a new tree or new trees of Settlement was vestd in the survivg or continuingtrees or tree (if any) wher such surviving trees or tree shd be willing to continue to act in other respects or not) or if thr shd be no survivg tree then in the exors or admors of then then last survivg tree

P. W.R. Trafford being a person/full age hd become absolutely and benefly entitled in pesson to the land comprised in the Settlement free from all limitations powers and



Trafford ALL & Singular the heredits premes comprad in ad Vestg Deed (except such part or parts that (if any) as my means of any sale exchange portion or orse hi been disposed of or parted with or become extinguished) AND ALSO (by way of conveyence and not of exception) all other frhold heredits (if any) to wh the sd ?. W.R. Trafford was entitled under or by virtue of the sd Settlement TO HOLD the same unto the sd R.R.W.R.Trafford in fee simple DECLARON that Trees were disched from the Trust so far as regarded to heredits & premes thrby conveyed EXTED by all parties and duly attested BY HIS WILL of this date the ad Richard Randolph William Hawson Trafford after revoks all former Wills ste, apptd his Mother Betting Mend Capper and William George whtsvr and whrsvr to his sd Nother for her own use and benefit absolutely SOD by Testor abd duly attested 1945 January The sd R.R.W.R. Trafford died on this date on War service The sd Will was duly prvd on this date in Ppl Probate Regy by ad W.G.
