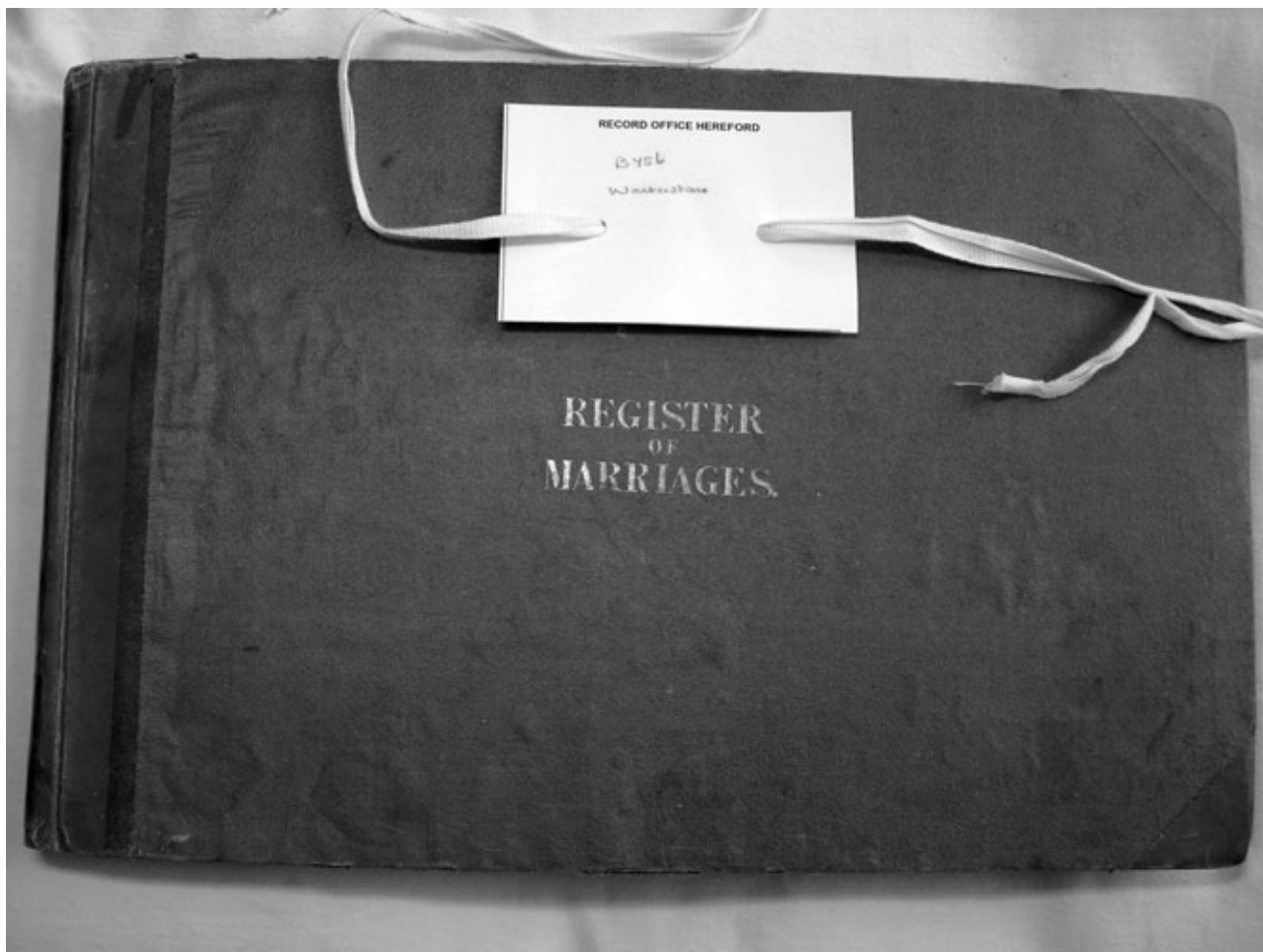

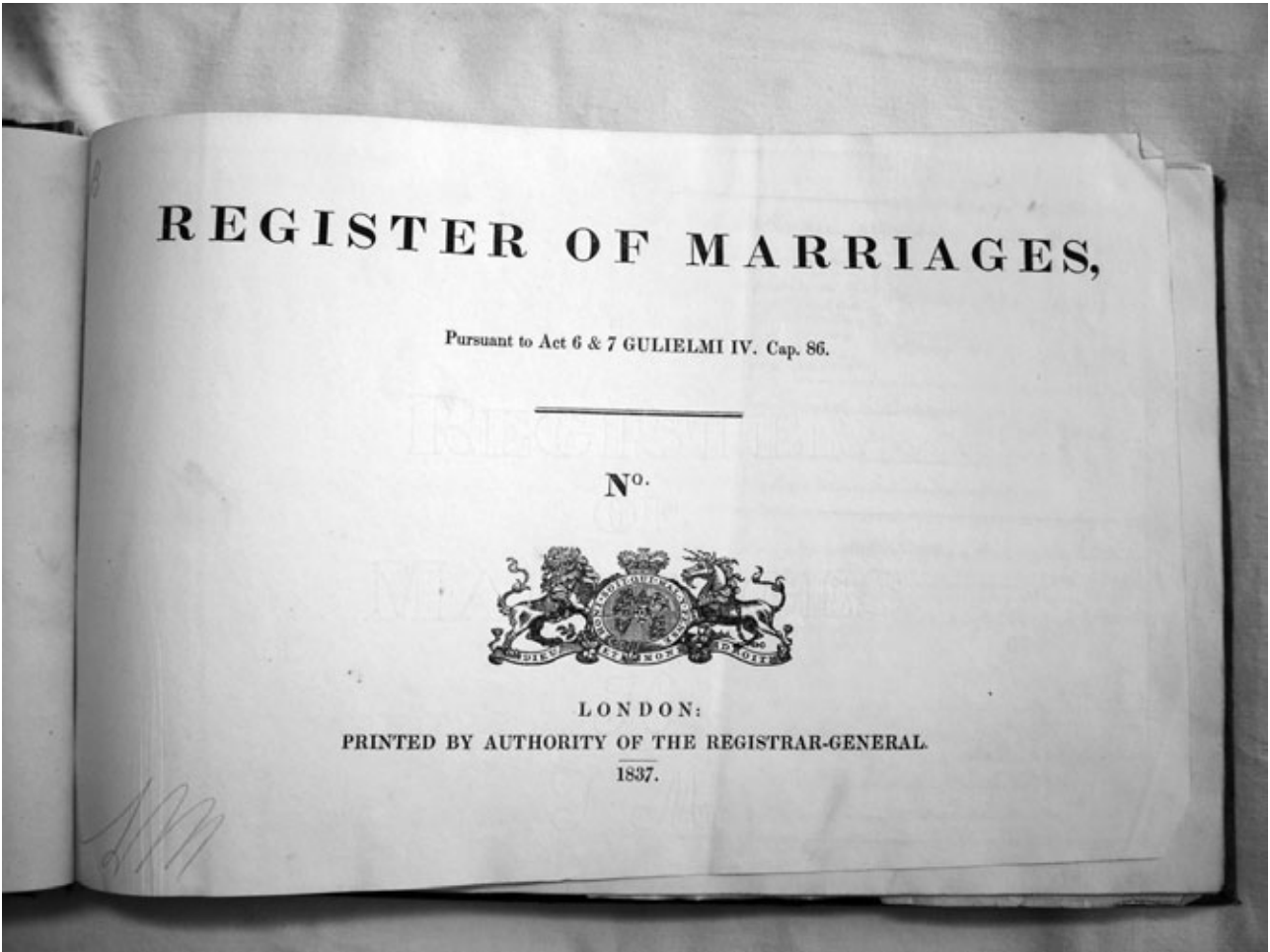

Entries in Marriage and Baptismal Registers  
 in cases of adopted persons.

I give below an extract of the Report of the Commission called together at the request of the Archbishop by the General Secretary of the Church of England Moral Welfare Council with regard to questions relating to the above matters, and it is my wish that these recommendations of the Commission should be acted upon in this Diocese.

**Marriage Registers.** The Commission recommends that they see no reason to depart from the procedure with regard to entries in the Marriage Register which has been laid down already by the Registrar General in the handbook of "Suggestions for the guidance of the Clergy," page 7, paragraphs 26 and 27, which has been in circulation since 1952, namely, that the adoptive father's name is to be entered under the heading "father's name and surname", as if he were the natural father of the child, except in cases where a woman has adopted the child, or at the request of the party to be married when he is known by a surname other than that of the adopters.

**Baptismal Registers.** The Commission recommends that where a person is baptised after adoption, the practice followed already by many clergymen of entering the adopter's name as parents without qualification, save in exceptional cases, could be continued for the present. The exceptional cases would be - when the adopters wish for the insertion of the words "the adopted child of ..." or when a woman alone adopts a child, or where the surname of the child differs from the name of the adopters. The Commission were of the opinion that the name of the natural parent should not be entered unless the clergyman is requested to do so by the adopting parents.
